DOMESTIC LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

INSTRUCTIONS:

- STEP 1:** A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY MUST BE FORMED AND EXECUTED BY TWO OR MORE PERSONS AS MEMBERS; THE "ARTICLES" MUST ALSO SET FORTH THE RIGHT, TERMS AND CONDITIONS, IF GIVEN, TO ADMIT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS; THE RIGHT, IF GIVEN, BY REMAINING MEMBERS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS AFTER DISSOCIATION; AND ANY OTHER PROVISIONS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE LAW.
- STEP 2:** THE NAME OF THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY MUST CONTAIN THE WORDS LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY OR L.L.C.
- STEP 3:** FILE THE ORIGINAL AND TWO COPIES OF THE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE LLC'S REGISTERED OFFICE IS LOCATED. THE JUDGE OF PROBATE'S FILING FEE IS \$35 AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S FILING FEE IS \$40.
- STEP 4:** FILE A COMPLETED REPORT OF DOMESTIC LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FILING THE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION WITH THE JUDGE OF PROBATE. THE FILING FEE IS \$5.

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ALABAMA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY ACT, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION.

- Article I** The name of the Limited Liability Company.

- Article II** The duration of the Limited Liability Company is FIFTY YEARS.
- Article III** The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purpose(s):
