CORPORATION WARRANTY DEED  
JOINT WITH RIGHT OF  
SURVIVORSHIP

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of other good and valuable considerations and the sum of ONE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00 CENTS (US\$195,900.00) Dollars to the undersigned GRANTOR in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Cameo Construction Co., Inc., a Corporation (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto James C. Moore and wife, Margaret Moore, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 443, according to the Survey of Weatherly Broadmoor Abbey, Sector 25, as recorded in Map Book 21, Page 1, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

This conveyance is hereby made subject to restrictions, easements and rights of way of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
