STATE OF ALABAMA WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR
 LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO
COUNTY OF SHELBY SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of other good and valuable considerations and the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00 CENTS (US\$500.00) to the undersigned GRANTORS in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Jack Frank Watts Jr. and wife, Ann A. Watts, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Jack Francis Watts Jr. and wife, Ann A. Watts, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 54, according to the Map and Survey of Brook Chase Estates Phase I, as recorded in map Book 21, Page 49, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Note: The purpose of this deed is to vest title in Jack Francis Watts, Jr., and wife Ann A. Watts, jointly for life with remainder to survivor. Note: Jack Frank Watts, Jr., and Jack Francis Watts, Jr., are one and the same person.

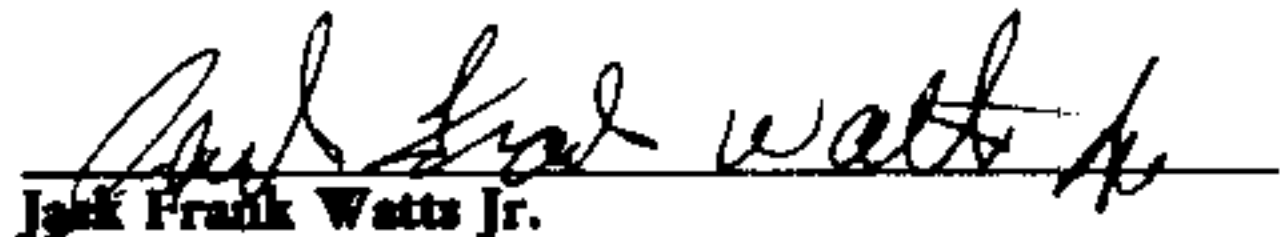
This conveyance is hereby made subject to restrictions, easements and rights of way of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

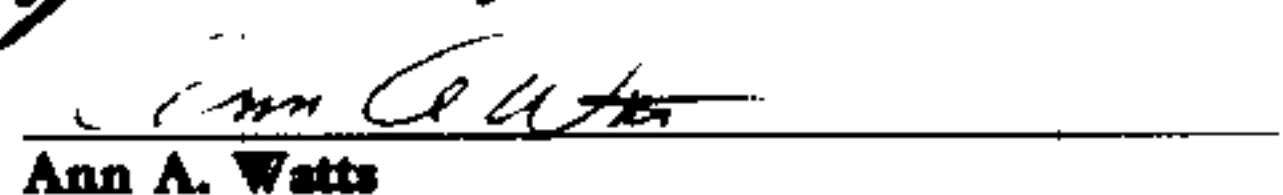
Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining in fee simple.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto GRANTEES for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion.

And said GRANTORS do for themselves, their successors and assigns covenant with the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise noted above, that they are entitled to the immediate possession thereof; that they have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that they will and their heirs and assigns shall, warrant and defend the same to the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and seals on this the 30 day of MAY, 1997.

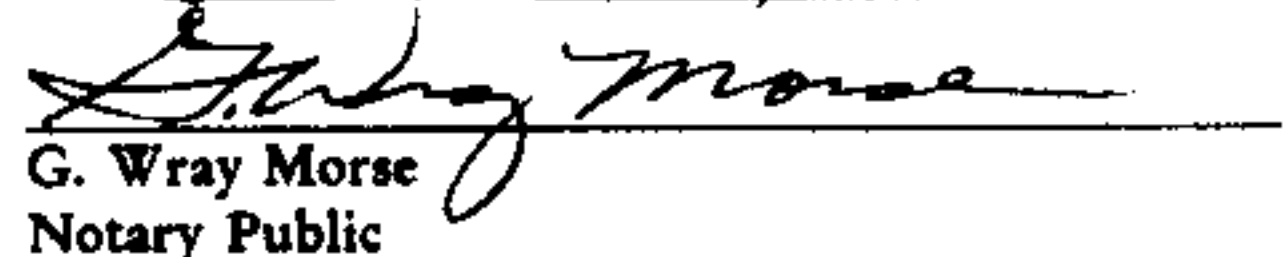
