

SPECIFIC DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Lori Connell, a legal resident of Sumner County, State of Tennessee have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Mark S. Connell, who resides in Sumner County, State of Tennessee, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact to act in, manage, and conduct all my estate and all my affairs, and for that purpose for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and to execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds, and executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds, and things necessary to accomplish the following:

1. I specifically authorize and grant to my said attorney-in-fact full power and authority to do, take, and perform all and every act and everything whatsoever requisite, proper or necessary to be done in the purchase and mortgage of the property hereinafter described, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power to execute and sign my name to a mortgage with a principal balance of \$10,276.00 at a rate of 8.25% in equal installments for a period of thirty (30) years (360) months on said property to Pinnacle Bank, its successors and/or assigns as their interest may appear and with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my attorney-in-fact, or his substitute, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this Power of Attorney and the rights and powers herein granted as to the following described property:

And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney-in-fact shall be binding on myself, and my heirs, legal and personal representative, and assigns; whether the same shall have been done before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been actually received by my attorney.

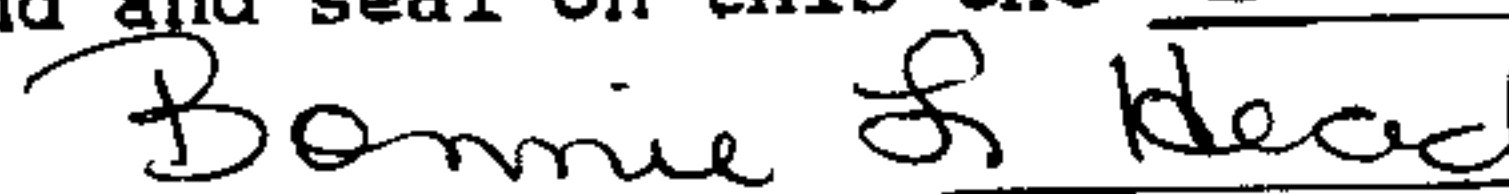

Begin at the SE corner of Lot 8, Block 1, of Cahaba Valley Estates, Fourth Sector, as recorded in Map Book 5 page 127 in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; thence in a Southerly direction along the West boundary of Wilderness Court a distance of 147.51 feet to the beginning of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 25.00 feet and a central angle of 90 deg; thence along arc of said curve a distance of 39.27 feet to end of said curve; thence in a Westerly direction a distance of 112.00 feet; thence 90 deg.
