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LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

STATE OF: CONNECTICUT, COUNTY OF: NEW HAVEN

FEDERAL HOME LOAN MORTGAGE CORPORATION (FHLMC), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, having an office for the conduct of business at 8200 Jones Branch Drive, McLean, VA, 22102, constitutes and appoints:

FIRST NATIONWIDE MORTGAGE CORPORATION

The undersigned gives to said attorney-in-fact full power and authority to execute such instruments as if the undersigned were personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming all that said attorney-in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done by authority hereof.

This limited power of attorney has been executed and is effective as of the 1st Day of October, 1994, and the same shall continue in full force and effect until the occurrence of any of the following events or until revoked in writing by the undersigned:

- (i) the suspension or termination of the attorney-in-fact as a Seller or Servicer of mortgages to FHLMC,
- (ii) the transfer of servicing from the attorney-in-fact to another Servicer for cause,
- (iii) the appointment of a receiver or conservator with respect to the business of the attorney-in-fact, or
- (iv) the filing of a voluntary or involuntary petition in bankruptcy by the attorney-in-fact or any of its creditors.

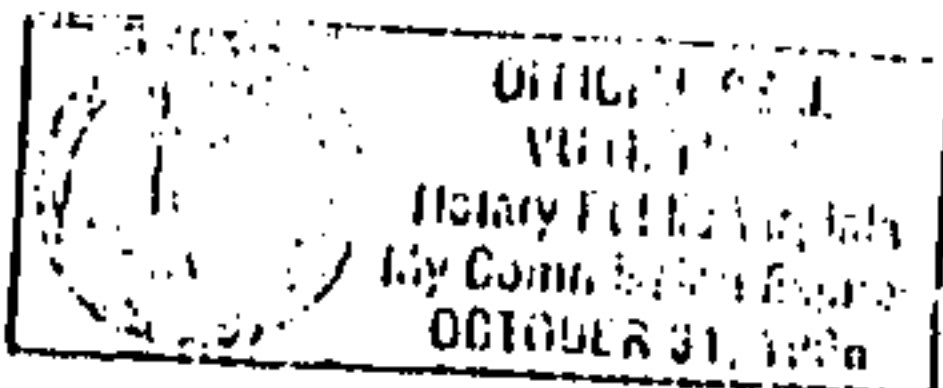
