ORDER

The above-styled matter came on to be heard on a **PETITION FOR REMOVAL OF DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE** on April 22, 1997. This Court took the above-styled matter under advisement for preparation of a Court Order. Present for the proceeding were the following: Felicia Lynn Knowles, said minor's Guardian Ad Litem, Cindy Sirmon, said child's mother, Terri Long, and her retained counsel, H. L. Conwill. It is noted for the record that said minor's father is deceased.

This Court ascertained that all parties were apprised of the nature of the pending allegations, the nature of the proceeding, the dispositional alternatives available to the Court and of rights, including the right to counsel, the right to a Guardian Ad Litem, and the right to a hearing.

This Court proceeded to hear the sworn testimony of Felicia Lynn Knowles and Terri Long.

Wherefore, having considered the sworn testimony and the relevant, competent, and material evidence in addition thereto, and noting the concurrence of all parties present, this Court **FINDS** that it is in the best interest of the minor, Felicia Lynn Knowles, to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age.

Wherefore, this Court **ORDERS, ADJUDGES and DECREES** that Felicia Lynn Knowles shall be relieved of the Disabilities of Non-Age. Such judgment shall have the effect of investing Felicia Lynn Knowles with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally, to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if 19 years of age.

Guardian Ad Litem fees in the sum of **\$150.00** and Court costs in the sum of **\$72.00 (TOTAL - \$222.00)**, are taxed to the Petitioner, Terri Long. Said sum shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court by **JULY 15, 1997 AT 9:00 A.M.**

Payments Ordered herein shall be paid on or before the date cited herein, Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., and shall be paid by cashier's check, money order (or, if in person, by cash), payable to Dan Reeves, Clerk of Court, at: P.O. Box 1810, Columbiana, Alabama 35051. Payments should include reference to the above case number. THE CLERK WILL NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT BY PERSONAL CHECK.

The Clerk is **ORDERED** to mail a copy of the Court Order to Felicia Lynn Knowles, Terri Long, H. L. Conwill and Cindy Sirmon.
