CORPORATION FORM WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

Hinkle (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Mineral and mining rights excepted

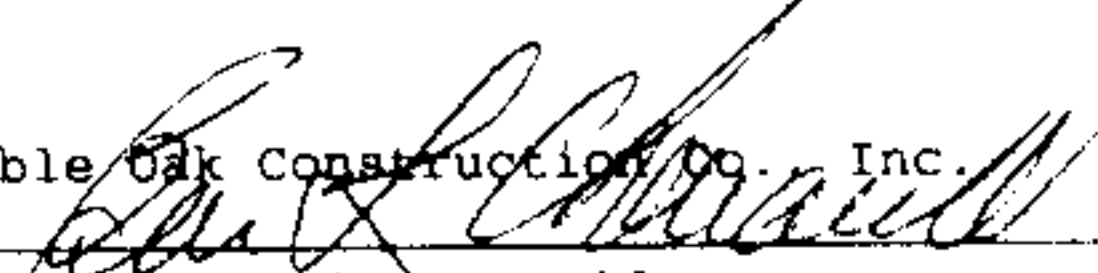
Subject to existing easements, current taxes, restrictions, set-back lines and rights of way, if any, of record.

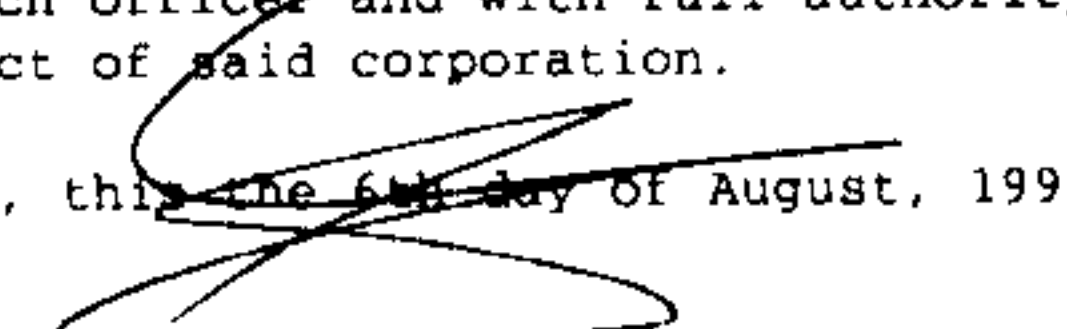
