Commence at the Northwest corner of said Section 2; thence run East 985.58 feet along the North section line; thence run right 136°02'41" and run Southwest 307.01 feet; thence turn left 16°45'33" and run Southwest 160.51 feet; thence turn right 20°19'46" and run Southwest 215.88 feet; thence turn left 111°05'55" and run Southeast 445.66 feet to a point on the East right of way of Industrial Park Drive and the point of beginning; thence turn right 65°55'05" and run South along said right of way 436.47 feet to the point of a counter-clockwise curve having a delta angle of 09°11'18" and a radius and a radius of 447.47 feet; thence run along the arc of said curve 71.76 feet; thence turn left 81°35'54" from tangent and run East 490.42 feet; thence turn left 93°34'18" and run North 73.88 feet; thence turn right 01°20'46" and continue North 219.90 feet; thence turn left 00°30'12" and continue North 212.37 feet; thence turn left 110°04'11" and run Southwest 248.05 feet; thence turn right 46°47'58" and run Northwest 259.95 feet to the point of beginning. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
