ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under Title 10, Chapter 12 of the Coded of Alabama, (1975), as amended (the "Alabama Limited Liability Company Act") hereby file the following Articles of Organization with the probate judge of the county in which the initial registered office of the limited liability company will be located and affirm that the facts stated in these Articles of Organization are true and correct:

ARTICLE 1 Name

The name of the limited liability company ("Company") is BW Leasing Company, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II **Duration**

The company shall continue in existence until it is dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the operating agreement, or, if there is no operating agreement or no provision in the operating agreement governing the duration of the Company, then in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act.
