- 1. The name of the corporation is AFRICAN MINISTRIES EVANGELISTIC ASSOCIATION, INC.
 - 2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. This corporation is organized for the purpose of spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ, specifically, but not limited to countries located on the continent of Africa. This will be a Christian Evangelistic Outreach Association and will provide spiritual, corporal, educational, financial, evangelical, and other assistance to natives and residents of the continent of Africa. To establish a foundation to contribute money for the education and/or other financial and evangelical assistance to the inhabitants of the continent of Africa.

This corporation is not organized for monetary gain or any purpose or activity outside those permitted by §501(c)(3) and § 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. This corporation shall not engage in any activities not permitted in the above sections of the Internal Revenue Code, regardless of any other provision of these articles.

3a. Said corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3)

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code) or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

- 4. This corporation shall have no members as such.
- 5. The Board of Directors shall consist of no less than three (3) and no more than fifteen (15) directors. The number of directors may be adjusted within this range by amendment to the Bylaws.

The president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer of the corporation shall be ex officio members of the Board of Directors.

Any director elected or appointed may be removed from office by a majority of the directors of the corporation in a meeting duly assembled whenever, in their judgment, the best interests of the corporation will be served.

- 6. The officers of the corporation shall consist of a president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer to be elected every three (3) years by the Board of Directors. Election of such officers shall be held at such time and in such manner as is provided for in the corporation Bylaws upon expiration of the terms of the original officers.

 Officers may be removed from office by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the entire Board of Directors of the corporation in a meeting duly assembled whenever, in their judgment, the best interests of the corporation will be served.


