AMENDMENTS TO RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

A declaration of restrictive covenants made and entered into on August 3, 1987 by Gibson- Anderson-Evins, Inc. an Alabama corporation and recorded in miscellaneous book 144 pages 124 through 135.

Said covenants concern and were involved with the development of lots of a subdivision known as Saddle Run, Map book 11, Page 28 as recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.

These amendments to the restrictive coveants were passed and approved by two thirds of the owners of the lots of Saddle Run and are in addition and addendum to the original restrictive covenants.

That said amendments are pursuant to paragraph 23 of said restrictive covenants and shall be entered as paragraph 25 AND 26 to the restrictive covenants.

Said Amendment shall read as follows:

25. That a two third majority owners of the lots in Saddle Run have formed a Saddle Run Neighborhood Association [Homeowners Association hereinafter called "Association"]. That the owners of said lots wish to provide a means by which to enforce the restrictive covenants and to provide for the upkeep and maintenance of the common areas of Saddle Run. That attachd hereto are the bylaws of the Saddle Run Neighborhood Association which are attached as Exhibit "A" and which shall become Exhibit "A" to this amendment and to the restricitive covenants.

26. That the terms and conditions set forth in the by-laws of the Saddle Run Neighborhood Association shall be enforceable against all lots within Saddl Run. The failure of any owner to abide by the restrictive covenants and Exhibit "A" may result in that lot being liened in an amount necessary to make the appropriate repairs, to correct any violations of the covenants or by-laws, to enforce member dues and fees that said "association" may by and through its elected officers use any legal and equitable means available by law and by these documents to maintain the integrity and upkeep of the Saddle Run Neighborhood.
