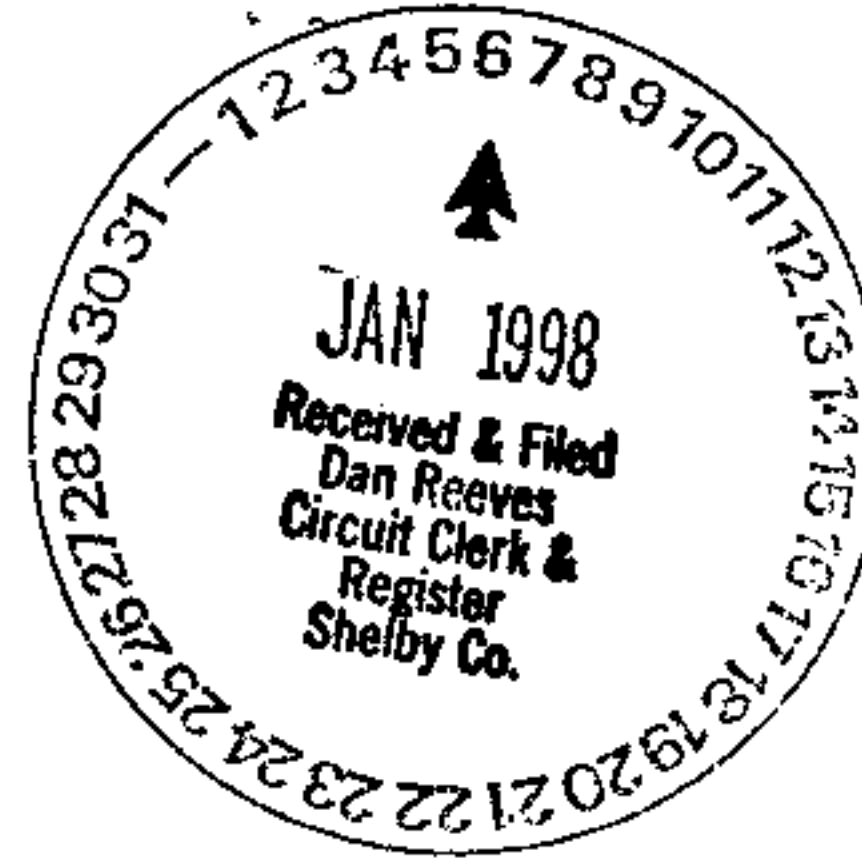

The Court being advised on the written agreement between the parties, finds that same is due to be ratified and approved. It is therefore **ORDERED** as follows:

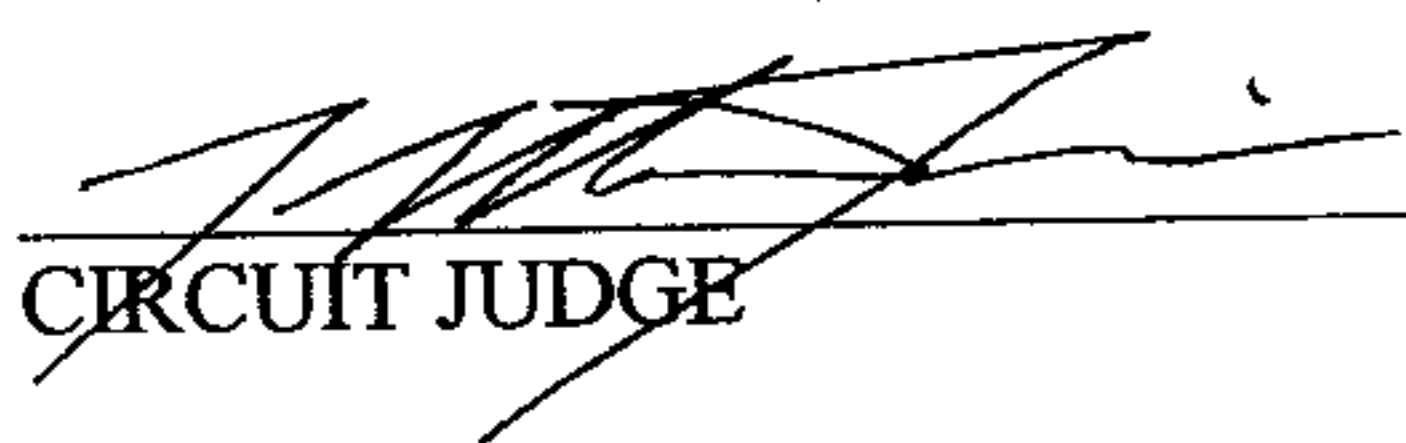
