AMENDED FINAL JUDGMENT

The plaintiff having filed a Motion to Alter or Amend Final Judgment, and to Dismiss Remaining Claims between Defendant, Frances R. Watts, and plaintiffs, James R. Taylor and wife, Sylvia Ann Taylor, and the plaintiffs and remaining defendants having no objections thereto, and upon consideration thereof, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That the Southeast corner of the property owned by the defendant, Frances R. Watts, and the Northeast corner of the property owned by the plaintiffs, James R. Taylor and wife, Sylvia Ann Taylor, is located at an approximate 3-inch iron at the intersection of the chain link fence and old wire fence, and the boundary line of the parties shall be from said 3-inch open iron and in an approximate Westerly direction along the old wire fence, and to the white encased iron pipe, at or near the Highway 11 right of way, being the Southwest boundary of the property owned by the defendant, Frances R. Watts, and the Northwest boundary of the property owned by the plaintiffs, James R. Taylor and wife, Sylvia Ann Taylor.

2. That all remaining claims in this cause of action of defendant, Frances R. Watts, and plaintiffs, James R. Taylor and wife, Sylvia Ann Taylor, as against one another, are hereby dismissed with prejudice.
