ITEM ONE.

I direct that all of my just debts, including expenses of my last illness, funeral and burial, be paid by my Executrix out of my estate as soon as convenient after my death.

ITEM TWO.

I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Ethel Snyder Brown, all the rest, residue and remainder of my property of every character and description, real, personal and mixed, wherever situated.

ITEM THREE.

I nominate and appoint my wife, Ethel Snyder Brown, Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and do hereby expressly exempt her from making or giving any bond or other security for performance of her duties as such Executrix and any accounting or settlement, partial or final, with or in any Court whatsoever. I do grant to my said Executrix full power and authority to sell any property, real or personal, owned by me at the time of my death or to which my estate may become entitled, at public or private sale at such price and on such terms as she, in her sole discretion, may see fit without any order, approval or confirmation of or by any Court whatsoever.

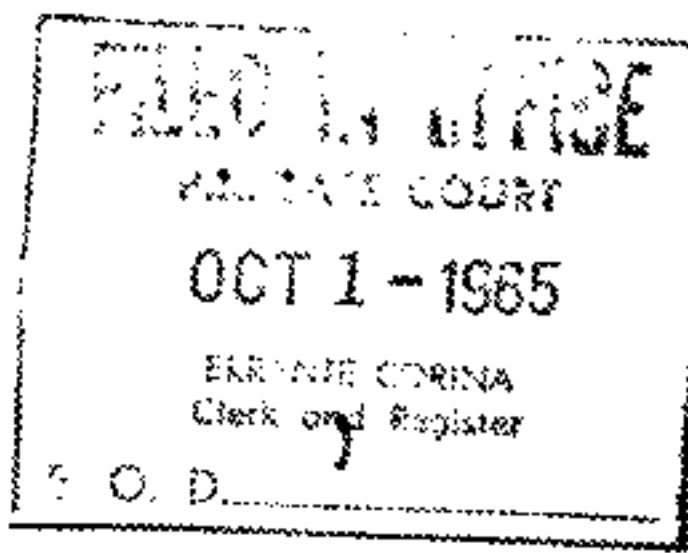
