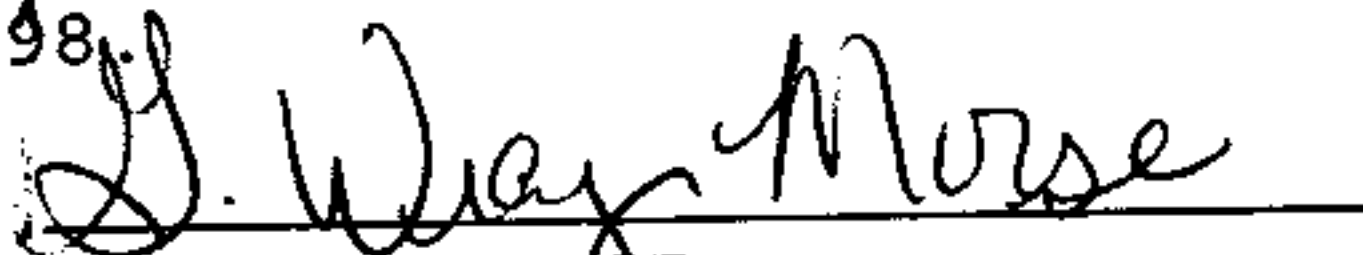
In preparing that certain deed, the marital status in the notary section contained a typographical error.
