

GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all men by these presents, that I, **Margie L Bright**, 751 Morgan Street, Montevallo, AL 35115, in Shelby County Alabama, pursuant to §26-1-2 of the *1975 Alabama Code*, hereby make, constitute, and appoint my son **Larry David Bright**, of 8779E Railroad Street, Pinson, AL 35126, my Attorney in Fact, giving unto the said Attorney in Fact full power to do anything that I may legally do through an Attorney in Fact, including an absolute power of disposition, not accompanied by any trust, over all my property and the right to direct and manage my medical care. I hereby ratify and affirm that which my Attorney in Fact or substitute shall do or cause to be done. I hereby revoke any previous powers of attorney I may have executed.

This power of attorney shall become effective upon my disability, incompetency, or incapacity.

This power of attorney shall be revoked upon my death, except that the Attorney in Fact may, without actual knowledge of my death, continue to act in good faith hereunder. An affidavit executed by the Attorney in Fact stating that he did not have, at the time of the exercise of the power, actual knowledge of the termination of the power by revocation or by the principal's death, is conclusive proof of the nonrevocation or nontermination of the power at that time, and any action so taken, unless otherwise invalid or unenforceable, binds the successors in interest of the principal. If the exercise of the power of attorney requires execution and delivery of any instrument that is recordable, the affidavit, when authenticated for record, is likewise recordable.
