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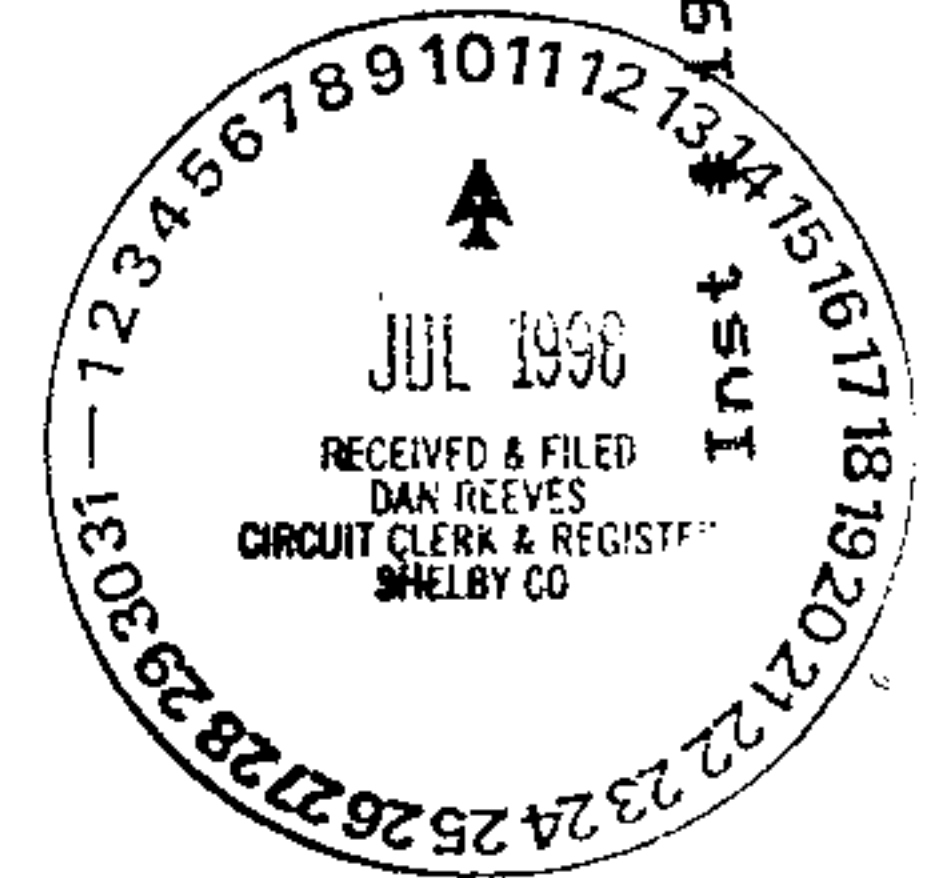

Upon consideration of the Plaintiff's Application for Entry of Default and Default Judgment and supporting testimony and affidavit presented at hearings, the Complaint and Proof of Service on the individual and the company named in the Complaint, and testimony and other evidence offered, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiffs have and recover, jointly and severally, of the named Defendants, specifically including, Jim Shubert as an individual, and Conveyor and Screen, Inc. and its representatives, the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000) in compensatory damages and Seventy-Four Thousand Dollars (\$74,000) in Punitive damages for intentional fraud and deceit, for a subtotal of One Hundred Thousand Dollars \$100,000, plus court costs of \$176 for a grand total of One Hundred Thousand, One Hundred and Seventy-Six Dollars (\$100,176.00).
