CONSENT ORDER ON MODIFICATION FOR VISITATION AND SUPPORT

The above-styled parties, after consultation with their respective attorneys by signatures herein, indicate that they have agreed to the following visitation and child support provisions:

I.

VISITATION

It is agreed by the parties that the Father shall have the right to have his children, i.e. JAMES LONNIE REED, date of birth March 21, 1986 and SAMANTHA DANIELLE REED, date of birth November 7, 1987, to visit with him at any time and place as is mutually agreed upon between the parties. If the parties cannot mutually agree, then the Father shall have the right to have said children visit with him every other weekend with the first weekend beginning on Saturday, July 8, 1989 at 9:00 a.m. to be returned at 7:00 p.m. The Father may then again visit with the children from 9:00 a.m. on that same weekend until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday.

For the first three visitations or the weekends of July 8 and 9, July 22 and 23, and August 5 and 6, these
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visitations shall be supervised by the Mother or anyone she appoints without cost to the Father.

The following four visitations and beginning on August 19 and 20, the time will be as stated above but they will be unsupervised. Specifically, these weekends include August 19 and 20, September 2 and 3, September 16 and 17 and September 30 and October 1.

Beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 14, 1989, the Father shall have the right to have said children visit for overnight visitation from Saturday at 9:00 a.m. until Sunday at 7:00 p.m. and to continue every other weekend until further order of this Court. However, during this overnight visitation, the Father and the children shall spend the night at Janet and William J. Williams, Sr.'s residence presently located at 549 Heartstone Drive, Marietta, Georgia.

Additionally, beginning Saturday, August 19, 1989, and continuing until further order of this Court, the Father shall be entitled to take the children to Birmingham, Alabama for the primary purpose of visitation their grandfather, James Reed. However, said out-of-state visitation shall be limited to once every six weeks and the children are to be returned at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday of that weekend.

It is further agreed by the parties, that in the event that the Father removes the children from the supervision of this Court without the Mother's permission and in violation

of this order, the Father agrees that this may be considered kidnapping.

II.

CHILD SUPPORT

The Father shall begin by paying to the Mother the total sum of ~~\$325.00 per month~~ \$187.50 per month per child for the support of the minor children beginning on the 15th day of July, 1989 and payable on the 1st and 15th day of each month thereafter in bi-monthly payments in the amount of \$187.50 on the 1st and \$187.50 on the 15th.

The Father's obligation for the support and maintenance of the minor children of the parties continues until said children reach the age of eighteen (18) years, marriage or dies or becomes self-supporting, whichever first occurs. Payments shall be mailed to Paula June McEwen at 1429 Noel Drive, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia 30319.

III.

MOBILE HOME

The parties, together with James W. Reed, have title to a 1987 Commodore Frontier Mobile Home, cream in color, size 70 x 14, serial number 22084. The Mother hereby agrees to transfer possession and disclaims any right, title, and interest in and to said mobile home. The Mother further agrees to transfer her interest by bill of sale to said mobile home. By this agreement, the Father agrees to be totally and fully responsible and liable for the payment of any and all debts associated with said mobile home or

secured with said mobile home until same is fully paid and freed of any and all possible liens. Further, the father agrees that he shall indemnify the Mother should he default in payments of the trailer and same be repossessed and any possible penalties or deficiencies be assessed against her.

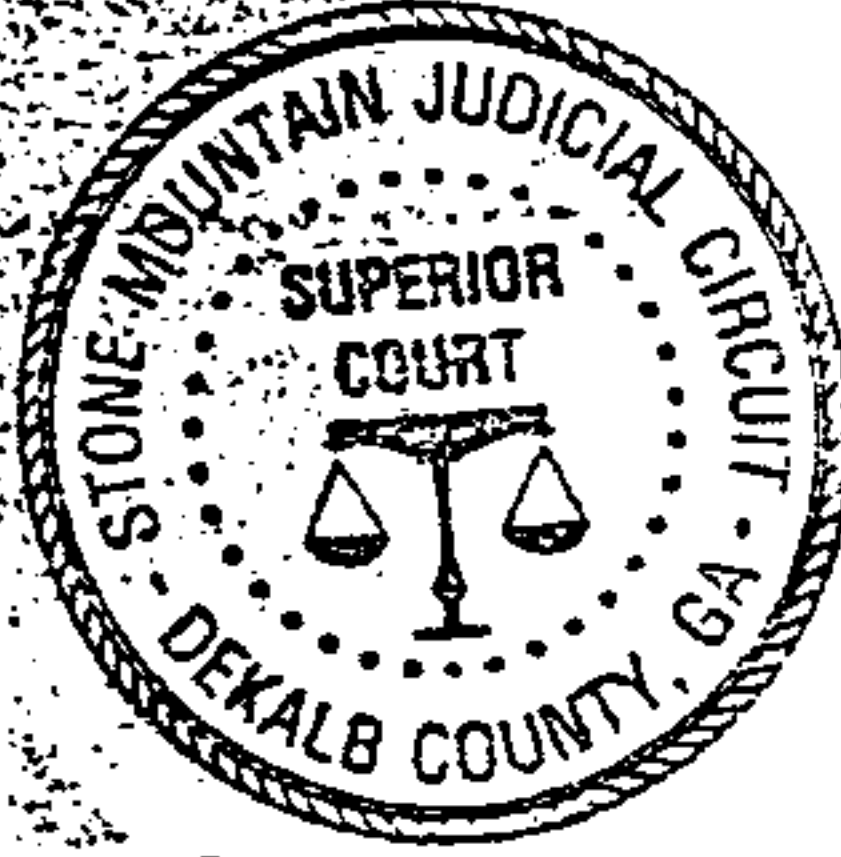
