

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Jill A. Macfadyen, a legal resident of the State of Texas, United States of America, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Andrew J. Macfadyen, who resides in Bexar County, State of Texas, my true and lawful attorney in fact to act in, manage, and conduct my affairs and for that purpose for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and to execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds, and executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds, and things, that is to say that these presents are intended to constitute a Durable Power of Attorney:

1. I specifically authorize and grant to my said attorney-in-fact full power and authority to do, take, and perform all and every act and everything whatsoever requisite, proper or necessary to be done in the sale and transfer of the property hereinafter described, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power to execute and sign my name to any deed transfer of title or title affidavit on said property and with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my attorney-in-fact, or his substitute, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this Power of Attorney and the rights and powers herein granted as to the following described property:

GIVING AND GRANTING unto said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present. This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a Durable and Specific Power of Attorney. This Durable Power of Attorney shall not be affected by my disability, incompetency or incapacity. Such rights, powers and authority shall remain in full force and effect

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thereafter until my death.

And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney shall be binding on myself, and my heirs, legal and personal representative, and assigns; whether the same shall have been done before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been actually received by my attorney.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, as principal, I have signed this Durable Power of Attorney this the 8th day of August, 1998, and I have directed that photographic copies of this Power be made which shall have the same force and effect as an original.
