FIRST: I direct that all my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral, shall first be paid out of my estate by my executor hereinafter named, as soon as possible after my death.

SECOND: I give, bequeath and devise all of my property, real, personal and mixed of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever located to my beloved son, MARSHALL RAY DAVIS, absolutely.

THIRD: Should my son predecease me, I give, bequeath and devise all of my property, real, personal and mixed of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever located to GLORIA F. DAVIS, absolutely. If my son and GLORIDA F. DAVIS predecease me, I give, bequeath and devise all of my property, real, personal and mixed of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever located to RUPERT SIMUEL MULLALLY.

FOURTH: I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved son, MARSHALL RAY DAVIS, to serve as Executor under this my Last Will and Testament. In the event that he shall fail to qualify, die, resign, become incompetent, or otherwise fail or cease to serve as Executor, then I appoint GLORIA F. DAVIS as Executrix hereunder.

(c) I direct that he shall serve as Executor without compensation, except that he shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for extraordinary services.
