ORDINANCE NO. 98-012

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of October, 1998,

ALABAMA POWER COMPANY, an Alabama Corporation, filed a petition with the City of Alabaster, Alabama, as required by Section 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, petitioning and requesting that the property hereinafter described be annexed to the municipality of the City of Alabaster, Alabama, which petition contained an accurate description of the property proposed to be annexed together with a map of said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Alabaster, Alabama, and the signature of the owner of the property described was signed thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Alabaster, Alabama, does adopt this Ordinance assenting to the annexation of the following described property to the municipality of the City of Alabaster:


