ITEM ONE: It is my will that all of my legal debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as is practicable.

ITEM TWO: I will, devise and bequeath to my husband, ROLAND H. HENSON, all real, personal and mixed property of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled in equity at the time of my death.
