WHEREAS, the title of Alabama Power Company to the property hereinafter described is subject to the lien of the Indenture dated as of January 1, 1942, as amended and supplemented (hereinafter called the Indenture), executed by Alabama Power Company (hereinafter called the Company) to Chemical Bank & Trust Company, as Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the name Chemical Bank & Trust Company was changed to Chemical Bank New York Trust Company and said Chemical Bank New York Trust Company thereafter merged into Chemical Bank and said Chemical Bank thereupon became successor Trustee under the Indenture, and the name of Chemical Bank was changed to The Chase Manhattan Bank; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to, and upon compliance with the provisions of Section 10.03 of the Indenture, the Company has requested the undersigned, as Trustee under the Indenture, to release such property from the lien of the Indenture.

NOW THEREFORE, The Chase Manhattan Bank, as successor Trustee, under the authority of Section 10.03 of the Indenture, does hereby release and quitclaim from the lien of the Indenture (subject to the exceptions and reservations set forth in the hereinafter described deed, if any) all its right, title and interest in and to the following described property located in Shelby County, Alabama:

Parcel 4

A parcel of land located in a portion of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 01, Township 24 North, Range 15 East of Shelby County, Alabama more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the Southwest corner of Lot 302 of Recreational Cottage Site Sector 4 as shown in Map Book 22, Page 52 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama, said point being on the east right-of-way of a county road, marked by a 5/8 inch rebar; thence North 04°03'56" East a distance of 188.22 feet along the east right-of-way of said county road to the Northwest corner of Lot 302 of said Subdivision, marked with a 5/8 inch rebar, said point being the Point of Beginning of the hereinafter described parcel; thence North 04°03'56" East a distance of 100.00 feet along east right-of-way of said county road to a 5/8 inch rebar; thence South 81°30'10" East a distance of 320.32 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 302 of said subdivision, said point being on the 397 foot contour of Lay Lake; thence South 80°48'26" West a distance of 22.00 feet along the north property line of Lot 302 of said subdivision to a 1 1/2 inch capped iron pipe; thence South 80°48'26" West a distance of 306.11 feet to the point of beginning. Said Parcel containing 0.37

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acres more or less. All bearings refer to the Alabama West Zone Grid.

The above described property is the same property described in and conveyed by Statutory Warranty Deed dated June 9, 1998 between Alabama Power Company and Frank R. Griffin and wife, Martha P. Griffin.
