**DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, which are intended to constitute a Durable Power of Attorney, that we, **ELIZABETH KILLCREAS AHO, CHRISTINA ANNETTE KILLCREAS, KELLY DIANE KILLCREAS, and AMELIA JANE KILLCREAS**, the undersigned, do hereby make, constitute and appoint **CHRISTINA PFEIFFER KILLCREAS**, of Starkville, Oktibbeha County, Mississippi, as my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me in my name, place and stead, and on my behalf and for my use and benefit.

To exercise or perform any act, power, duty, right, or obligation whatsoever that I now have, or may hereafter acquire the legal right, power or capacity to exercise or perform, in connection with, arising from, or relating to any person, item, transaction, thing, business, property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, or whatsoever.

This power of attorney shall be limited to the authority to execute such documents as are necessary to grant to Shelby County, Alabama right of ways for public roads through the Pfeiffer properties located in Shelby County, off highway 26 in which the undersigns have an undivided interest and to execute such documents as will result in the vacation of certain right of ways through such properties presently existing.

To lease, purchase, exchange, and acquire, and to agree, bargain, and contract for the lease, purchase, exchange, and acquisition of, and to accept, take, receive, and possess any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or intangible, or interest thereon, on such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as my said attorney in fact shall deem proper;

To maintain, repair, improve, manage, insure, rent, lease, sell, convey, subject to liens,

mortgage, subject to deeds of trust, and hypothecate, and in any way or manner deal with all or part of any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or intangible, or any interest therein, that I now own or may hereafter acquire, for me, in my behalf, and in my name and under such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as my said attorney in fact shall deem proper;

To conduct, engage in, and transact any and all lawful business of whatever nature or kind for me, on my behalf, and in my name;

To make, receive, sign, endorse, execute, acknowledge, deliver and possess such applications, contracts, agreements, options, covenants, conveyances, deeds, trust deeds, security agreements, bills of sale, leases, mortgages, assignments, insurance policies, bills of lading, warehouse receipts, documents of title, bills, bonds, debentures, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, letters of credit, notes, stock certificates, proxies, warrants, commercial paper, receipts, withdrawal, receipts and deposit instruments relating to accounts or deposits in, or certificates of deposit of, banks, savings and loan associations, credit unions, or other financial institutions or associations, proofs of loss, evidences of debts, releases, and satisfaction of mortgages, liens, judgments, security agreements and other debts and obligations and such other instruments in writing or whatever kind or nature as may be necessary or proper in the exercise of the rights and powers herein granted;

I grant to my said attorney in fact full power and authority to do, take, and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite, proper, or necessary to be done, in the exercise of any of the rights and powers herein granted, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney in fact, or their substitute, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this power of attorney and the rights and powers herein granted.

This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a durable and general power of attorney. The enumeration of specific items, rights, acts, or powers herein is not intended to, nor does it, limit or restrict, and is not to be construed or interpreted as limiting or restricting, the general powers herein granted to my said attorney in fact. This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability, incompetency, or incapacity of the principal.

This Power of Attorney has been granted by me with the expectation that my attorney in fact may desire to file this instrument for record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama or in any other appropriate recording office in the United States or in any other country, and to exhibit certified copies hereof to any person with whom they deal hereunder. In the event that such is done, any purchaser or other person who deals with my said attorney in fact may conclusively presume that this Power of Attorney has not been revoked unless and until an instrument of revocation has been filed for record in said recording office where this document has been filed.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, as Principal, we have signed this Durable Power of Attorney in Birmingham, Alabama, this 13th day of March, 1999, and we have directed that photographic copies of this power be made which shall have the same force and effect as an original.


