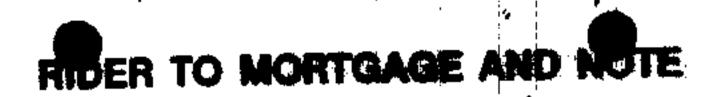

- 3. Lander in Possession. Upon acceleration under Paragraph 21 or abandonment of the Property, Lender (in person, by agent or by judicially appointed receiver) shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property including those past due. Any rents collected by Lender or the receiver shall be applied first to payment of the cost of management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to receiver's fees, to payment of the cost of management of the Property and collection of rents, including, but not limited to receiver's fees, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorney's fees, and then to the sums secured by this Security Instrument.
- 4. The invalidity of any provisions of the Note, Mortgage or this Rider shall not affect the validity of other provisions.
