5. NELL ABBOTT, compensatory and punitive damages in the amount of \$35,625.00.
6. MARGARET BARBER, compensatory and punitive damages in the amount of \$35,907.00.
7. PEGGY ROSE, compensatory and punitive damages in the amount of \$36,103.00.

The Defendants are further taxed with costs of Court, jointly and severally.
