KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND NO/100's (\$274,900.00) to the undersigned grantor, LEWIS INTEGRITY HOMES, INC., a corporation, (herein referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEE herein, the receipt of whereof is acknowledged, the said GRANTOR does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto JAMES C. AYERS and KAYE S. AYERS (herein referred to as GRANTEES) as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in SHELBY County, Alabama:

Lot 937, according to the Survey of Highland Lakes, 9th Sector, Phase I, an Eddleman Community, as recorded in Map Book 24, Page 1, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
