

GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

STATE OF ALABAMA
SHELBY COUNTY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Robert A. Odgers, Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint my son, Robert P. Odgers, as my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit:

1. To ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, and receive all sums of money, debts, dues, accounts, legacies, bequests, interest, dividends annuities, and demands whatsoever as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, payable, or belonging to me and have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name or otherwise, and to compromise and agree to the same and give acquittances or other sufficient discharges for the same;

2. For me and in my name to make, seal and deliver, bargain, contract, agree for, purchase, receive, and take lands, tenements, and hereditaments, and accept the possession of all lands, and all deeds and other assurances, in the law therefor, and to lease, let, demise, bargain, sell, remise, release, convey, mortgage, and hypothecate lands, tenements, and hereditaments upon such terms and conditions and under such covenants as he/she shall think fit;

3. To bargain and agree to buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise, choses in action, and other property in possession or in action, and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business of whatsoever nature and kind;

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4. For me and in my name, and as my act and deed to sign, seal, execute, deliver, and acknowledge such deeds, leases, mortgages, hypothecations, bills of lading, bills, bonds, notes, receipts, evidence of debt, releases and satisfaction of mortgage, judgments and other debts, and such other instruments in writing of whatsoever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises;

5. To sign, endorse, negotiate, deposit, withdraw, transfer, and otherwise deal with any checks, drafts, deposits, accounts, cash, and any other form of money, bank account, investment account, or other deposit;

6. And to give consent for medical treatment, examine medical records, and otherwise do what I may do myself regarding medical treatment and medical records.

, GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney-in-fact, full power and authority to do and perform every act necessary, requisite, or proper to be done in and about the premises as fully as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.

This power of attorney shall become not be affected by my disability, incompetency, or incapacity. If, following execution of this power of attorney, a court of my domicile appoints a guardian, conservator, or other fiduciary charged with the management of all of my property, or all such property except

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specified exclusions, the court shall appoint Robert P. Odgers
except for good cause or disqualification.
