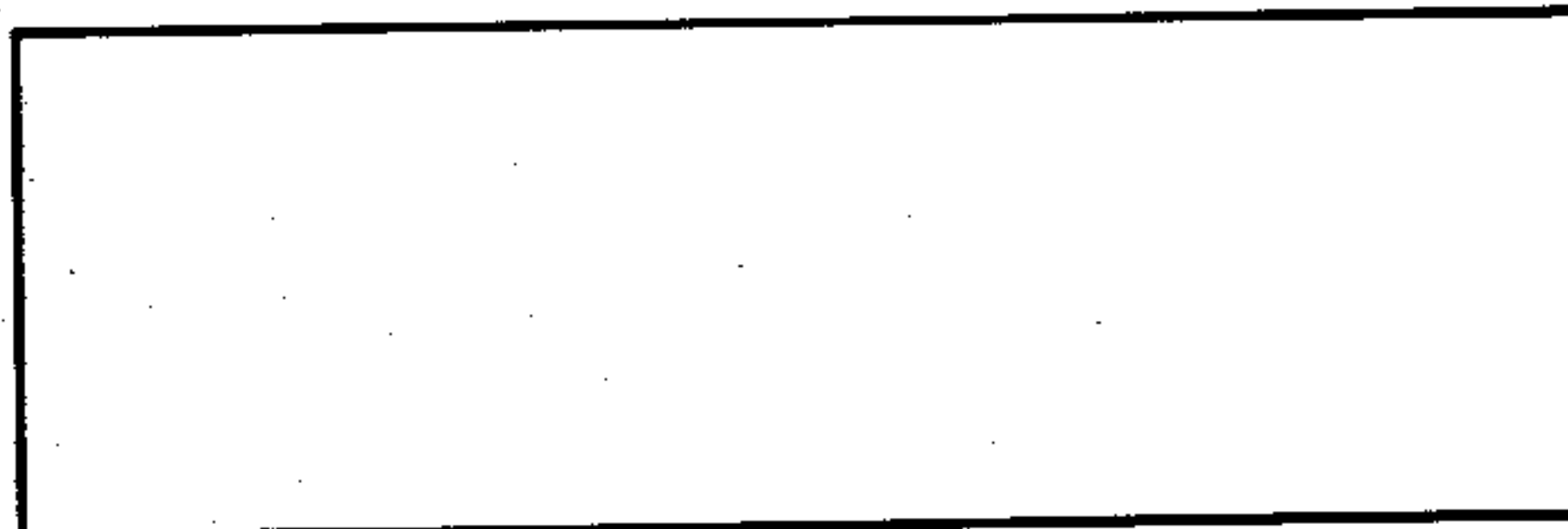
As of 08/04/1999, the obligor owes unpaid support in the amount of \$69,511.98 and this lien amount may be subject to interest.

All non-exempt real and personal property including, but not limited to, the following: wages or other compensation, any and all claims for damages or choses-in-action, stocks, bonds or other securities, mortgages or liens on any real or personal property, promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange or other commercial paper, judgments, savings bond or other government-issued bonds or securities, any interests in oil, gas or mineral leases, certificates of deposit, letters of credit, money orders, cashier's checks, traveler's checks, bank deposits, or escrow funds, trusts or trust funds, Keogh plans, individual retirement accounts, profit-sharing plans, deferred compensation plans, pension plans, pre-paid funeral plans, retirement benefits or other retirement plans, leases, life estates, remainder interests or other interests in real property, patents, trademarks, copyrights, service marks, franchises or other such licenses.

The priority and enforcement aspects of this lien are governed by the law of the state where the property is located. 
