- 2. The owner(s) hereby give his/her/their assurance that the system shall be installed, and that the completed installation shall be certified by an engineer. The owner(s) and his/her/their successors in title and assigns hereby give his/her/their assurance that he/she/they will provide adequate maintenance for the system and that the system shall not receive hazardous waste, monbiodegradable waste, or any waste which may contain high levels of metals, or chemicals from industrial, agricultural, or chemical establishments. The system shall receive only domestic liquid waste containing animal or vegetable matter in suspension or solution, and may include liquids containing chemicals in solution from water closets, urinals, lavatories, bathtubs, showers, laundry tubs or devices, floor drains, drinking fountains, or other sanitary fixtures.
