

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION  
OF  
BUD WEBER MORTGAGES, L.L.C.**

Pursuant to the Provisions of Act No. 93-724 of the 1993 Alabama Legislature, the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

**ARTICLE I**

**NAME**

The name of the Limited Liability Company shall be "BUD WEBER MORTGAGES, L.L.C.".

**ARTICLE II**

**DURATION**

The period of duration shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE III**

**PURPOSES**

The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purposes:

1. The offering of loans to the public, secured by mortgages against property presented as collateral, and all kinds of business transactions normally associated with this kind of activity.

2. Any other purpose which may be legal for limited liability companies to do in the State of Alabama, and which are not required to be specifically set forth herein.

## ARTICLE VIII



### RIGHT TO CONTINUE BUSINESS
