**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons, acting as incorporators to form a non-profit corporation pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-3A-1, et seq., of the 1975 Code of Alabama, as last amended, and Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, the undersigned persons desiring to effect a non-profit body corporate, in accordance with applicable law, have agreed upon and adopted these Articles of Incorporation, the same to constitute and become a charter for carrying on the activities hereinafter specified upon the proper filing hereof pursuant to law.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be TEMPLE OF GOD ASSEMBLY CHURCH.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose or purposes for which this non-corporation is organized are:

- (a) To establish a non-profit body corporate of worshipers and believers known as Temple of God Assembly Church, to engage in the worship, praise and ministry of God, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit, promoting peace on earth and good will toward all persons, establishing and distributing to a world of Christian believers, "Daily Bible Memory Verses", and to otherwise engage in any and all church, religious and educational activities, that they deem necessary and appropriate.
- (b) To purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, and otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, tangible or intangible, or any interest therein, wherever situated.

- (c) To sell, convey, lend, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, invest, reinvest, take and hold as security, transfer and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- (d) To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, whether for profit or not for profit, associations, partnerships or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States, or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.
- (e) To elect or appoint officers and agreements of the corporation, who may be directors or members, and define their duties and fix their compensation, if any.
- (f) To make and alter bylaws, not inconsistent with its articles of incorporation or with the laws of Alabama, for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the corporation.
- (g) To make donations for the public welfare or for religious, charitable, scientific, or educational purposes, or otherwise.
- (h) To engage in religious, charitable, scientific and educational training and school activities.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall not have or exercise any power or authority, either expressly, by interpretation, or by operation of law, or shall it directly or indirectly engage in any activity that would prevent this corporation from qualifying (and continuing to qualify) as a non-profit corporation described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have one class of members. There shall be no limitation of the number of members except as provided by in the bylaws of the corporation. All other qualifications, rights, and duties of the members of said corporation shall be set out and established in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI

The location and mailing address of the initial registered office for the corporation shall be 136 Magnolia Circle, Columbiana 35051. The name of the initial registered agent at such address shall be Minister Raymond L. Stewart.

ARTICLE VII

The officers of the corporation shall consist of a President and Secretary-Treasurer, and such other officers as may be provided in the Bylaws, who shall be elected by the Director constituting the initial Board of Directors. The name of the person who will serve as the initial Director is Aredia N. Stewart, 136 Magnolia Circle, Columbiana, Alabama 35051.

ARTICLE VIII

The name and address of the incorporators are Minister Raymond L. Stewart and Aredia N. Stewart, who both reside at 136 Magnolia Circle, Columbiana, Alabama 35051.

ARTICLE IX


The following special provisions shall be applicable to this non-profit corporation:

- (a) The corporation reserves the right to alter, amend, modify, change, or repeat any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter provided by law, and all rights conferred upon the Directors herein are granted subject to this reservation.
- (b) The corporation shall have the power to make bylaws for the regulation and government of this corporation, its agents, servants and officers, and for all other purposes not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama.
- (c) The voting members of the corporation shall have the authority to adopt such rules, bylaws and regulations for the governing of the corporation, as they may deem necessary or expedient.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the incorporators of this non-profit corporation, have hereunto set their hands and seals, and pray that this instrument shall be filed recorded as provided by that these incorporators, their successors and assigns, shall constitute a non-profit body corporate under the name hereinabove set forth, with all powers to which said corporation may be entitled under the laws of the State of Alabama, on this 25 day of October, 1999.

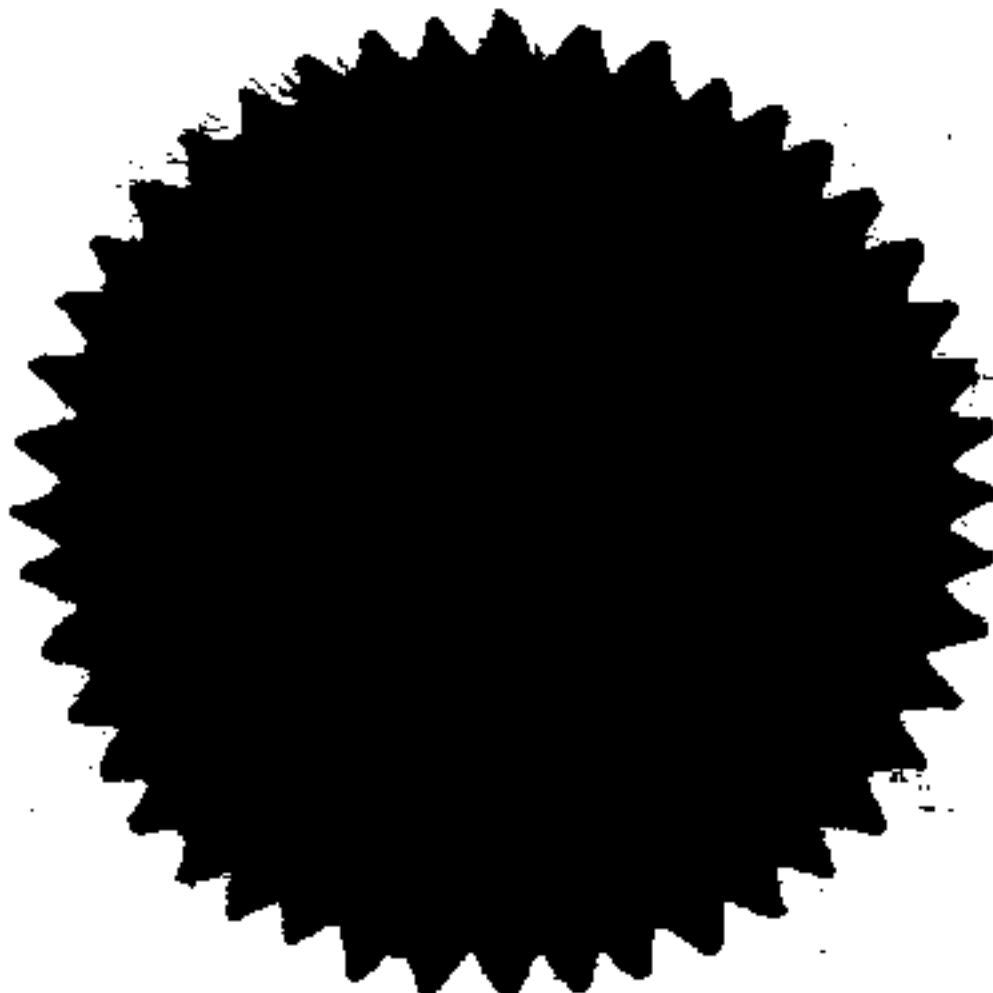
