

GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

NOTICE: This legal document gives the person named as Attorney-in-Fact broad powers over the property of the Grantor, unless limited by the terms of the document itself. These powers may exist for an unlimited time period unless limited by the terms of the Document itself. The grantor may revoke this power of attorney at any time. **Do not sign this Power of Attorney unless you understand all its terms.**
