KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVEN DOLLARS AND NO/100^{ths} (\$235,407.00) to the undersigned grantor, LEWIS INTEGRITY HOMES, INC., a corporation, (herein referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of whereof is acknowledged, the said GRANTOR does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto HOWARD L. CANNON and RONDA L. CANNON (herein referred to as GRANTEES) as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in SHELBY County, Alabama:

Lot 810, according to the Survey of Forest Parks - 8th Sector, 1st Phase, as recorded in Map Book 25, at Page 130, and Instrument No. 1999-28778, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to:

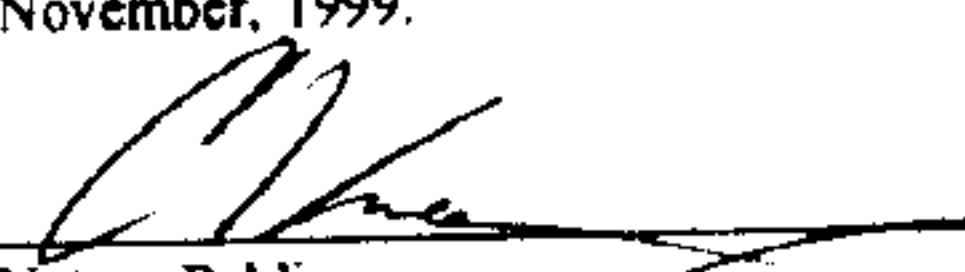
