ARTICLE I

I direct that all of my just debts, costs of my last illness, and funeral expenses shall be first paid out of my estate. I also direct that my Co-Executor pay out of the residue of my estate all estate, transfer and inheritance taxes, and all costs of administration of my estate, that shall be assessed against my estate or against any devisee.

ARTICLE II

I direct that after payment of all administration expenses and death taxes as hereinabove provided, all the rest, residue and remainder of the property which I may own at the time of my death, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, and of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, including all of the property which I may acquire or become entitled to after the execution of this Will, including all lapsed legacies and devises, I bequeath and devise to my beloved wife, WILLIE MAE WHITE.

ARTICLE III

In the event that my beloved wife, WILLIE MAE WHITE, should predecease me, then I bequeath and devise all the rest, residue and remainder of my property that I may own at the time of my death, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, and of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, including all property which I may acquire or become entitled to after the execution of this Will, including all lapsed legacies and devises, to be equally divided between my beloved nephews, LARRY WHITE and JEFFREY

ARTICLE IV

I hereby name my beloved wife, ~~WILLIE~~ MAE WHITE, and my beloved nephew, LARRY WHITE, to be the Co-Executors of my said Will without being required to give bond or other surety.
