DIVORCE DECREE

On this day comes for hearing the Complaint of the Plaintiff, Mark H. Merritt, appearing in person and by his attorney, Melinda R. Gilbert, P.A., and the Defendant, Susan L. Merritt, appearing not, and it appearing that due service of process by summons against said Defendant, for the time and in the manner prescribed by law, issued on the Complaint herein, has been made in this cause; and this action having been reached upon the call of the calendar is submitted to the Court for its consideration and judgment upon the Complaint of the Plaintiff, and the testimony of Plaintiff, and that of Christine Woodall, a witness on his behalf, from which along with the argument of counsel and other evidence before the Court, the Court finds:

- That this Court has jurisdiction of this cause of action, the parties hereto, and of the marital status.

- 6. That there are no property rights or debts to be adjudicated by this Court. Each party shall have and hold as their separate property, any and all property currently in their possession, and shall hold each other harmless for any debt associated with said property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that each party be, and they are hereby, permanently restrained and enjoined from A any threats, intimidation, annoyance, harm or harassment directed toward the other.

And the Court hereby retains jurisdiction of this cause for the purpose of adjudging and awarding to the Plaintiff his interest and rights to and in the property and property rights owned by the Defendant and for the purpose of ascertaining or enforcing all rights and obligations of the parties under this decree, and for other proper purposes.
