

## **MORTGAGE**

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED FEBRUARY 24, 2000, between VISHWANATHA RAO and SUDHA RAO, HUSBAND AND WIFE, whose address is 1301 DEER TRAIL RD, BIRMINGHAM, AL. 35226 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and AmSouth Bank, whose address is 175 Main Street, Trussville, AL. 35173 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MONTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, grants, bergains, sells and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all sessments, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or krigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oit, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in SHELBY County, State of Alabama (the "Real Property"):

LOT 39 ACCORDING TO THE AMENDED MAP OF GREYSTONE FARMS NORTH PHASE I AS RECORDED IN AMP BOOK 23 PAGE 57 IN THE OFFICE OF THE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY ALABAMA TOGETHER WITH A NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT TO USE THE PRIVATE ROADWAYS, COMMON AREA AND HUGH DANIEL DRIVE AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THE GREYSTONE FARMS NORTH DECLARATION OF COVENANTS CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS IN INSTRUMENT #1996-17498

THE REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED ABOVE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE THE HOMESTEAD OF THE GRANTOR.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as VANCANT LOT 362 NORTH LAKE RD, HOOVER, AL 35242.

Grantor presently seeigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property in addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEPLETIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Granter. The word "Granter" means VIBHWANATHA RAD and SUDHA RAD. The Granter is the mortgager under this Mortgage.

Quarantor. The word "Querantor" means and includes without limitation each and all of the guarantors, surstice, and eccommodation parties in connection with the Indebtedness.

improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, buildings structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions, replacements and other construction on the Real Property

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expanded or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expanses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage together with Interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage, and any and all other present or future, direct or contingent liabilities or indebtedness of any person who signs the Note to the Lender of any nature whatsoever, whether classified as secured or unsecured except that the word "Indebtedness" shall not include any debt subject to the disclosure requirements of the Federal Truth-In-Lending Act if, at the time such debt is incurred, any legally required disclosure of the lien afforded hereby with respect to such debt shall not have been made.

Lender. The word "Lender" means AmSouth Bank, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgegee under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all essignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated February 24, 2000, in the original principal amount of \$69,300.00 from Grantor to Lander, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The maturity date of this Mortgage is February 25, 2005.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements loan agreements, environmental agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with the Indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other banafits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage. Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9801, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Resulthorization Act of 1988, Pub. I. No. 99-499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 6901, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of

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the foregoing. The terms "hezardous waste" and "hezardous substance" shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by products or any fraction thereof and asbestos. Grantor represents and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, about or from the Property: (b) Grantor has no knowledge of or reason to believe that there has been, except is previously disclosed to and ecknowledged by Lender in writing. (i) any use, generation. manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threstened release of any hazardous waste or substance on, under, about or from the Property by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (ii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person relating to such matters; and (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) neither Grantor nor any tenent, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hezardous waste or substance on, under, about or from the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Grantor authorizes Lander and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests, at Grantor's expense, as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections of tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or hability on the part of Lender to Grantor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due diligence in investigating the Property for hazardous waste and hazardous substances. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims egainst Lander for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and 167 agrees to indemnify and hold hermises Lender against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of this section of the Mortgage or as a consequence of any use. generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or threetened release of a hazardous waste or substance on the properties. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lien of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Property. whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Nulsance. Waste. Grantor shall not cause; conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lander.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property Without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements settlescory to Lender to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lander's Right to Enter. Lander and its agents and representatives may anter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to estend to Lander's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Morrgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all lows, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lander's sole opinion, Lander's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lander may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lander. To protect Lander's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to ebendon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - COMMENT BY LEMBER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the fleat Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal, beneficial or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, fand contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the fleat Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation, partnership or limited liability company, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock, partnership interests or limited liability company interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender it such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Alabama law.

TAXES AND EIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long se Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend Itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or essessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lander at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished. Of any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurance containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Each insurance policy also shall include an endorsement providing that coverage in favor of Lender will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Grantor or any other person. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood Insurance for the full unpaid principal belance of the loan and any prior liens on the property securing the loan, up to the maximum policy limits set under the National Flood Insurance Program, or as otherwise required by Lender, and to maintain such insurance for the term of the loan.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shell promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner astisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the researchable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default under this Mortgage. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to pay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal belance of the indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that

would materially affect Lander's interests in the Property, Lander on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lander deems appropriate. Any argunt that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate provided for in the Note from the deteincurred or paid by Lender to the data of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during eigher. (i) the payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage else will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY: DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than these set forth in the Real Preparty description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion. issued in tevor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lander.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grentor's title or the interest of Lander under this Mortgage. Grentor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lander's own choice and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws. ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Application of Net Precede. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by aminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation. Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the sward shall mean the award after payment of ell reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Lander in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take auch staps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Granton will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lifen on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, tees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Texes. The following shell constitute texes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tex upon this type of Mortgage or upon all of any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage: (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tex on all or any portion of the indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grentor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (se defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or. (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liene section and deposits with Lender cesh or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lander shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Landar to perfect and continue Landar's security Interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grentor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lander (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained teach as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this

Mortgage. FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will deuse to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lander, cause to be filed, recorded, rehited, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages. deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance. certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect. continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Granton Unless prohibited by tew or agreed to the contrary by Liender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lander for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Feat. If Grantor falls to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph. Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Landar as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of meking, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shell execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any tinancing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Morigage:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Fallure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance or any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Fallure of Grantor to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents:

False Statements. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage. the Note or the Related Documents is false or misleading in any material respect, either now or at the time made or furnished

Defective Collegeralization. This Mortgage or any of the Related Documents ceases to be in full force and effect (including failure of any collateral documents to create a valid and perfected security interest or lien) at any time and for any reason.

Death or Insolvency. The death of Grantor, the insolvency of Grantor, the appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property. Bry assignment for the benefit of creditors, any type of creditor workout, or the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor.

Foreclasure, Forfeiture, etc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help representation or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which if the basis of the foreclosure or forefeiture proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the indebtedness or any Guarantor of any of the indebtedness or any Guarantor of the indebtedness or disputes the validity of, or hability under, any Guaranty of the indebtedness.

Insecurity. Lender in good faith deems itself insecure.

RIGHTS AND NEMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declars the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property. Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rests. Lender shell have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpeid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rant or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lander in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Appeint Receiver. Lender shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lander's right to the appointment of a receiver shell exist whether or not the appearant value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lander shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Forestocure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Nonjudicial Sale. Lender shall be authorized to take possession of the Property and, with or without taking such possession, after giving notice of the time, place and terms of sale, together with a description of the Property to be sold, by publication once a week for three (3) successive weeks in some newspaper published in the county or counties in which the Real Property to be sold is located, to sell the Property (or such part or parts thereof as Lender may from time to time elect to sell) in front of the front or main door of the counthouse of the county in which the Property to be sold, or a substantial and meterial part thereof, is located, at public outcry, to the highest bidder for cash. If there is Real Property to be sold under this Mortgage in more than one county, publication shall be made in all counties where the Real Property to be sold is located, if no newspaper is published in any county in which any Real Property to be sold is located, the notice shall be published in a newspaper published in an adjoining county for three (3) successive weeks. The sale shall be held between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the day designated for the exercise of the power of sale under this Mortgage. Lender may bid at any sale had under the terms of this Mortgage and may purchase the Property if the highest bidder therefore. Grantor hereby waives any and all rights to have the Property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Tenancy at Sufference. If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Lander otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at sufference of Lender or the purchaser of the Property and shall, at Lender's option, either (a) pay a reasonable rental for the use of the Property, or (b) vacate the Property immediately upon the demand of Lender.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or available at law or in equity.

Sele of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled in exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shelt give Grantor ressonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Ressonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Waiver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict comptiance with that provision or any other prevision. Election by Lander to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lander's right to declare a default and exercise its ramedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such aum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate provided for in the Note. Expenses covered by this peragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for benkruptcy proceedings (including afforts to modify or vecate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports) surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurence, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor size will pay any court costs in addition to all other sums provided by law. Grantor agrees to pay attorneys' fees to Lander in connection with closing, amending or modifying the loan. In addition, if this Mortgage is subject to Section 5-19-10. Code of Alabams 1976, as amended, any attorneys' fees provided for in this Mortgage shall not exceed 15% of the unpaid debt after default and referral to an attorney who is not a salaried employee of the Lender.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing, may be sent by telefacsimile (unless otherwise required by law), and shall be effective when actually delivered, or when deposited with a nationally recognized overnight courier, or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Alabama. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate prested by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Pioperty at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written concent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Ggantor under this Mortgage shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall steam each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Mortgage.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons of circumstances. If feasible. any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricten and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and antoroschie.

Commences and Assigns. Subject to the Restations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and essigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor. Landar, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the inclubedness by way at torbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or liability under the indebtedness

Time to of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor haraby releases and weives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Alabama as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortosco.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lander in exercising any right shall operate as a walver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lander, nor any course of dealing between Lander and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

ARBITRATION. Any controversy, claim, dispute or issue related to or arising from (A) the interpretation, negotiation, execution, sesignment, administration, repayment, modification, or extension of this document or the loan (B) any charge or cost incurred under tis document or the loan (C) the collection of any amounts due under this document or any assignment thereof (D) any alleged tort related to or arising out of this document or the loan or (E) any breach of any provision of this document, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association (the "AAA Rules"). Any disagreement as to whether a particular dispute or claim is subject to arbitration under this paragraph shall be decided by arbitration in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph. Commencement of litigation by any person entitled to demand arbitration under this paragraph shall not waive any right that person has to demand arbitration with respect to any countercialm or other claim that may be made against that person, whether in, relating to, or arising out of such litigation, or otherwise. The Expedited Procesures of the AAA Rules shall apply in any dispute where the aggregate of all cisims and the aggregate of all counterclaims each is in an amount less then \$50,000. Judgement upon any award rendered by any arbitrator in any such arbitration may be entered in any Court haveing juriediction thereof. Any demand for arbitration under this document shall be made no later then the date when any judicial action upon the same matter would be barred under any applicable statue of limitations. Any dispute as to whether the statute of limitations bere the erbitration of such matter shell be decided by arbitration in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph. The locale of any arbitration proceedings under this document shall be in the county where the document was executed or such other location as is mutually cceptable to all parties. This document evidences a "transaction involving commerce" under the Federal Arbitration Act. WITH RESPECT TO DISPUTES SUBMITTED TO ARBITRATION, ALL RIGHTS TO A TRAIL BY JURY ARE HEREBY EXPRESSLY WAIVED.

Notwithstanding the preceding paragraph or the exercise of arbitration rights under this document, each party may (1) foreclose against any rest or personal property colleteral by the exercise of the power of sale under any applicable mortgage or security agreement or under applicable law, (2) exercise any self help remedies such as set off or repossession; or (3) obtain provisional or encillary remedies such as replevin, injunctive relief, attachment, or appointment of a receiver from a court having jurisdiction, before, during or after the pendency of any arbitration proceedings. This arbitration provision shell not be interpreted to require that any such remedies be stayed, absted or otherwise suspended pending any arbitration or request for arbitration. The exercise of a remedy shall not waive the right of either party to resort to arbitration

DEFENSE COSTS. In addition to the costs and expenses I have agreed to pay above, I will pay all costs and expenses incurred by Lander ansing out of or releting to any steps or actions Lander takes to defend any unsuccessful claim, allegation or counterclaim I may make against Lander Such costs and expenses shall include, without limitation, attorneys' fees and costs.
