A request for a stop sign on Dalton Drive and Hamilton Road was presented. Mayor Hayes asked the City Engineer to investigate and report to the Council at the next meeting.

Maryl Rice moved to appoint Mary Rockett to the Park Board for a full term and Georgejane Brogden as an associate member. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A contract with the Shelby Committee of 100 for \$10,000 was presented. Ken Maynard moved to approve the contract as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City from A-1, Agricultural to B-2 General Business on property located on Highway 261 near Stubbs Foundry and owned by Don Murphy. No one spoke in favor or opposition of the request. Ken Maynard moved to approve the rezoning as requested. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the Council, Jim Phillips moved to adjourn. Beverly Hall seconded the motion and all approved.

AN ORDINANCE TO ALTER, REARRANGE AND EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PELHAM, ALABAMA SO AS TO EMBRACE AND INCLUDE WITHIN THE CORPORATE AREA OF SAID CITY ALL TERRITORY WITHIN SUCH CORPORATE LIMITS AND ALSO CERTAIN OTHER TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO SAID CITY.
