Mortgagee may insure said property (but Mortgagee is not obligated to do so) for its insurable value against loss by fire, wind and other hazards for the benefit of Mortgagors and Mortgages or for the benefit of Mortgages alone, at Mortgages's election. The proceeds of such insurance shall be paid by the insurer to Mortgagee, which is hereby granted full power to settle and compromise claims under all policies, to endorse in the name of Mortgagors any check or draft representing the proceeds of any such insurance, and to demand, receive and give receipt for all sums becoming due thereunder. That those mortgagors who are obligated to pay the indebtedness hereby secured will well and truly pay and discharge such indebtedness as it shall become due and payable, including the note or notes described above, any renewals or extentions thereof, and any other notes or obligations of such Mortgagors to Mortgagee, whether now or hereafter incurred.

- 9 That if default shall be made in the payment of any of the indebtedness hereby secured, or in the performance of any of the terms or conditions of this mortgage.
