WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVORS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That in consideration of Thirty-four Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$34,000.00), and other good and valuable considerations, to the undersigned Grantor (whether one or more), in hand paid by Grantees herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, I, RANDALL H. GOGGANS, a married man (herein referred to as Grantor, whether one or more), grant, bargain, sell and convey unto DOUGLAS W. HAMILTON AND MARY C. HAMILTON (herein referred to as Grantees), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Described as Lot 3 according to the Survey of Oak Forest, as recorded in Map Book 25, Page 111 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

SUBJECT TO: (1) Taxes due in the year 2000, and thereafter; (2) Easements, restrictions and rights-of-way of record; (3) Mineral and mining rights not owned by the Grantor.

The property conveyed herein is not the homestead of any Randall H. Goggans or his spouse.

Grantor represents and warrants that there are no assessments due any governmental authority with respect to the property conveyed herein.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said GRANTEES for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion.

And we do for ourselves and for our heirs, executors and administrators covenant with the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise noted above; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Grantees, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
