(i) neither Grageor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other sutflerized user of the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, about or from the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Compliance with Covernmental Requirements. Granton shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in affect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long se, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abendon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lander may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" meens the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal, beneficial or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyence of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation, partnership or limited liability company, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock, partnership interests or limited limbility company interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lander if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Alabama law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liene on the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Payment. Grantor shell pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lander under this Morigage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following peragreph.

Right To Contact. Grantor may withhold payment of any tex, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lander's Interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lian arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien erises or, if a lien is filled, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filling secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lander in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shalf name Lander as an additional obliges under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lander satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lander at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Granter shall rectify Lander at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or meterials. Grenter will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grentor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lander. Policies shall be written by such indurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lander. Grantor shall deliver to Lander certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for feiture to give such notice. Each insurance policy also shall include an endorsement providing that coverage in favor of Lander will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Granter or any other person. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hexard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood Insurance for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan and any prior lians on the property securing the loan, up to the maximum policy limits set under the National Flood Insurance Program, or se otherwise required by Lender, and to maintain such insurance for the term of the Idan

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lander of any loss or damage to the Property. Lander may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (16) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election. apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien effecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the demaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfectory to Lender. Lander shell, upon satisfectory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimbures Grentor from the proceeds for the resignable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default under this Mortgage. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lander has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to pay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal belance of the indebtadness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired ineurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property. Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expende in so doing will bear interest at the rate provided for in the Note from the date incurred or peld by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand. (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either. (I) the

term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a belloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's meturity. This Mortgage also will assure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remadles to which Lander may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lander shall not be construed as curing the default so as to be Lander from any remady that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee ample, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion leaved in fever of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lander.

Defence of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the fewful claims of all paragraph. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lander under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expanse. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lander shall be antitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lander's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lander such instruments as Lander may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrents that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDENSEATION. The following provisions teleting to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of this Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lander may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoiction of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall meen the award after payment of all researchible costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shell promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPORITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes.

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stemps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as platfined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liene section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; PMANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a accurity agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Becurity Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lander, Grantor shall execute finencing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lander to perfect and continue Lander's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lander may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a finencing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lander for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lander and make it available to Lander within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lander

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grentor (debtor) and Lander (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained teach as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, reflied, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places se Lender may deam appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation attatements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sale opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to affectuate, complete, perfect continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the lens and security interests created by this Mortgage as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lander in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this persignaph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage. Lander shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lander's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage

Default on Indebtedness. Fallure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance or any other payment necessary to prevent filling of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Failure of Grantor to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents.

False Statements. Any werranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is false or misleading in any material respect, either now or at the time made or furnished

Defective Collegeralization. This Mortgage or any of the Related Documents ceases to be in full force and effect (including failure of any collegeral documents to create a valid and perfected security interest or lien) at any time and for any reason.

Death or insolvency. The death of Grantor, the insolvency of Grantor, the appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, any type of creditor workout, or the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency lews by or against Grantor.

Foregioeure, Forfeiture, std. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. However, this

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter. Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Hents including emounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right. Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lander as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand exleted. Appoint Receiver. Lender shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the flants from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Tenancy at Sufference. If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Lender otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at sufference of Lander or the purchaser of the Property and shell, at Lender's option, either (a) pay a reasonable rental for the use of the Property, or (b) variate the Property immediately upon the demand of Lender.

Waiver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Grantor also will pay any court costs in addition to all other sums provided by law. Grantor agrees to pay attorneys' fees to Lender in connection with closing, amending or modifying the loan.
