THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED MARCH 7, 2000, between JEFFREY W. CULTON and CHARLOTTE S. CULTON, HUSSAND AND WIFE, whose address is 1616 WINFIELD DR. GRANT OF MORTGAGE. Right To Contest. PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grentor shell procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on

a replacement back for the full incurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any solineurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lander. Policies shall be written by such incurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lander. Grantor shall deliver to Lander certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be canopiled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lander and not containing any discislener of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Each insurance policy also shall include an andoppement providing that coverage in favor of Lander will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Grantor or any other person. Application of Proceeds. Grentor shall:promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fifteen (16) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impeired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any flon affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lander. Compliance with Exacting inclabandness. During the period in which any Existing Indebtedness described below is in affect, compliance with the Insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shell constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

EXPENSITURES BY LESSORS. If Grentor fails to comply-with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Exeting Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lander's interests in the Property, Lander on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lander deems appropriate. Any amount that Lander expends in so doing will beer interest at the rate provided for in the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lander to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lander's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the credit line and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or. (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or. (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lander may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lander shall not be construed as curing the default so as to ber Lander from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEPENDE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all least and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or finel title epinion issued in favor of, and accepted by Lander in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lander.

Defence of Title. Subject to the exception in the peragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Landar under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Landar shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Landar's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Landar such instruments as Landar may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws. ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDESTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Exeting Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Mortgage securing the indebtedness may be secondary and interior to an existing lien. Grantor expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

No Modification. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, emended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lender. Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

COMDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to consumnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage:

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by aminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation. Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the sward be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Lander in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to perticipate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes: fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Borrower which Borrower is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Credit Agreement; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Borrower.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tex to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as: defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or {b} contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Lienis section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.
