Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

Right To Contest. Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall suthorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lander at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lander turnish to Lander advance sesurances satisfactory to Lander that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorhaments on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any colorurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Grantor shall also procure and maintain comprehensive general liability insurance in such coverage amounts as Lender may request with Lender being named as additional insureds in such liability insurance policies. Additionally, Grantor shall maintain such other insurance, including but not limited to hazard, business interruption and boller insurance as Lender may require. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Each insurance policy also shall include an endorsement providing that coverage in favor of Lender will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Grantor or any other person.

Application of Precede. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss of Grantor falls to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and reper of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repeir, Grantor shall repeir or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a menner settefactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the researched cost of repeir or restoration if Grantor is not in default under this Mortgage. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to pay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principe) belance of the indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired inexpresse at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property

Grantor's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lender, however not more than once a year. Grantor shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing solicy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insurar; (b) the risks insured; (c) the amount of the policy. (d) the property each existing solicy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insured, the their current replacement value of such property, and the manner of determining that value; and (a) the expiration date of the policy. Grantor shall, upon request of Lander, have an independent appraiser satisfactory to Lander determine the cash value replacement cost of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's ingerests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Larider deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will beer interest at the rate provided for in the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lander to the date of regayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the belence of the Note and be epportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a belloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. Tiple. Granter warrants that: (a) Granter holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion leaved in fever of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Dutance of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Granton's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shell be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lander may request from time to time to permit such perticipation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws. ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities:

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in Seu of condemnation. Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all ressonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lander in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to perticipate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Granton will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such perticipation

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lander for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage: (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shell have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lander may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grentor either (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens; section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lander's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or raproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a piece reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lander and make it evallable to Lander within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lander

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Gode), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES: ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lander, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filed, recorded, refiled or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and pieces as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further essurance certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect continue, or preserve (s) the abligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the leans and security interests created by this Mortgage as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-In-Fact. If Grantor falls to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lander as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable. In Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the metters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness, including without limitation all advances secured by this Mortgage, when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage. Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a sustable satisfection of this Mortgage and suitable exetements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lander's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Granfor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lander from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lander, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Fallure of Grentor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Fellure of Grantor to comply with any other term, obligation, coverant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents.

Default in Favor of Third Parties. Should Grantor default under any loan, extension of credit, security agreement, purchase or sales agreement, or any other agreement, in favor of any other creditor or person that may materially affect any of Grantor's property or Grantor's sollity to repay the Note or Grantor's shifty to perform Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage or any of the Related Documents.

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Palse Statements. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is false or misleading in any material respect, either now or at the time made or furnished.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter. Lender, at its option may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law

Accelerate indebtedness. Lander shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lander shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts pest due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's coets, against the Indebtedness—in furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevogably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to degotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Tenancy at Sufference. If Grantor remains in possession of the Property efter the Property is sold as provided above or Lender otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at sufference of Lender or the purchaser of the Property and shall, at Lender's option, either (a) pay a reasonable rental for the use of the Property, or (b) vecate the Property Immediately upon the demand of Lender.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or available at law or in equity

Sale of the Property. Notice of Sale. Waiver: Election of Remedies. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Feet: Expenses. Annual Reports. Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance. It teasible any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Suppressors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. Weiver of Homesteed Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homesteed exemption laws of the State of Alebama as to all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be dearned to have waived any rights under this Mortgage for under the Related Documents' unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lander. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lander nor any course of dealing between Lander and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lander's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lander is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lander in any instance where such consent is required.
