

## ORDINANCE NO. 11-97-01

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of January, 1997 Joe L Tidmore and Charles O. Tidmore, filed a petition with the City Clerk of the City of Columbiana, Alabama as required by Section 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, code of Alabama 1975, petitioning and requesting that the property herein described be annexed to the municipality of the City of Columbiana, Alabama and requesting the Mayor and Council of said City to adopt an ordinance assenting to the annexation of said property to such municipality, which petition contained an accurate description of the property or territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Columbiana, and the signatures of the owner(s) of the property or territory described were signed thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Columbiana does adopt this ordinance assenting to the annexation of the following described property or territory to the municipality of the City of Columbiana. Said property being described as follows:

*Parcel Number 58-21-08-28-0-000-01 as described in Deed Book 351, Page 554 and Real Book 51, Page 988 in the office of Probate Judge, Shelby County Alabama and more particularly described as follows:*

*All that part of the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 1 West, lying East of Shelby County Highway No. 26 and all that part of the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 1 West, lying East of Shelby County Highway 26 and North of Alabama Highway No. 70.*

2. Be it further ordained that the corporate limits of the City of Columbiana be extended and rearranged so as to embrace and include such property or territory shall become a part of the corporate area of such municipality upon the date of publication of the Ordinance, as provided for in Section 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975.

3. Be it further ordained that the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance, along with an accurate description of the property or territory being annexed, together with a map of the said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Columbiana to which said territory is being annexed, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

4. Be it further ordained that the Zoning Map of the City of Columbiana, and any other official map or surveys of the City shall be amended to reflect the annexation of the above described property.

This ordinance was adopted and passed by the Mayor and Council of the City of Columbiana on this the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1997




**PETITION FOR ANNEXATION**
