WHEREAS, Mortgagor agreed in incurring said inclubedness that this mortgage should be given to secure the prompt payment of the indebtedness evidenced by the promiseory note or notes hereinabere specifically referred to, as well as any extension or renewal or refinancing thereof or any part or portion thereof, and also to secure any other indebtedness or indebtednesses used now or in the future by Mortgagor to Mortgagor, as more fully described in the next paragraph hereof (both of which different type debts are hereinafter collectively called "the Debt"), and,

WHEREAS, Mortgager may be or hereafter become further indebted to Mertgagee, as may be evidenced by promisency note or notes or otherwise, and it is the intent of the parties hereto that this mortgage shall secure any and all indebtednesses of Mortgager to Mortgages, whether new strating or hereafter arising, due or to become due, absolute or centingent, liquidated or unliquidated, direct or indirect, and, therefore, the parties intend this mertgage to secure not only the indebtedness evidenced by the promiseory note or notes hereinabove specifically referred to, but also to secure any and all other debte, obligations or liabilities of Mortgager to Mortgages, now existing or hereafter arising before the payment in full of the indebtedness evidenced by the promiseory note or notes hereinabove specifically referred to (such as, any future loan or any future advances, together with any and all extensions or renewals of same, or any part thereof, whether evidenced by note, open account, endorsement, guaranty, pledge or otherwise.

NOW, THEREFORE; in consideration of the premises, Mortgagor, and all others executing this mortgage, does (do) hereby grant, bargain, soil and convey unto the Mortgages the following described real estate, together with all improvements thereon and appartenances thereto, attuated to

Together with all the rights, privileges, tenements, appartenances and fixtures appertaining to the Real Estate, all of which shall be designed Real Estate and shall be conveyed by this meetings.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Real Estate into the Mortgages, its successors and assigns forever. The Mortgages covenants with the Mortgages that the Mortgages is inwfelly select in fee simple of the Real Estate and has a good right to sell and convey the Real Estate as aforestid, that the Real Estate is free of all encumbrances, unless otherwise set forth above, and the Mortgages will warrant and ferever defend the tothe Real Estate unto the Mortgages, against the lawful claims of all persons.

For the purpose of further securing the payment of the Debt, the Mortgagor agrees to: (1) pay all taxes, assumments, and other here taking priority over this mortgage (hereinafter jointly called "Liens"), and if default is made in the payment of the Liens, or any part thereof, the Mortgager, at its option, may pay the same, (2) keep the Real Retate continuously insured, in such manner and with such companies as may be satisfactory to the Mortgages, against loss by fire, vandalism, malicious mischief and other perils usually covered by a fire insurance policy with standard extended coverage endoments, with loss, if any, payable to the Mortgages, as its interest may appear; such manurance to be in an amount at least equal to the full insurable value of the improvements located on the Real Retate unless the Mortgages agrees in writing that such insurance therefor, shall be delivered to and held by the Mortgages until the Debt is paid in full. The original insurance policy and all replacements therefor, shall be delivered to and held by the Mortgages until the Debt is paid in full. The original insurance policy and all replacement therefor must provide that they may not be cancelled without the insurar giving at least fifteen days prior written notice of such cancellation to the Mortgages.

The Mortgagor heisely assigns and piciges to the Mortgages, as further security for the payment of the Debt each and every policy of hazard insurance may be hereafter in affect which insures said improvements, or any part thereof, together with all the right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to each and every such policy, including but not limited to all of the Mortgagor's right, title and interest in and to any premiums paid an such hazard insurance, including all rights to return premiums. If the Mortgagor fails to keep the Real Estate insured as specified above them, at the election of the Mortgages and without notice to any person, the Mortgages may declare the entire Debt due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed as hereinafter provided, and, regardless of whether the Mortgages declarate for its full insurable value (or for such lesser amount as the Mortgages may wish against such risks of loss, for its own benefit the proceeds from such insurance (less cost of collecting same), if collected, to be credited against the Debt, or, at the election of the Mortgages such proceeds for the payment of Lians shall become a debt due by the Mortgagor to the Mortgages and at once payable, without demand upon or notice to the foreigner, and shall be secured by the tien of this mortgage, and shall bear interest from date of payment by the Mortgages until paid at the rate provided in the processory note or notes referred to hereinabove.

As further security for the payment of the Debt, the Mortgagor hereby assigns and piedges to the Mortgagee the following described properly rights, claims, rents, profits, issues and revenues:

- 1. all rents, profits, issues, and revenues of the Real Estate from time accruing, whether under leases or tenancies now existing of hereafter created, reserving to the Mortgagor, so long as the Mortgagor is not in default hereunder, the right to receive and retain such rents, profits issues and revenues;
- 2. all judgments, awards of damages and settlements hereafter made resulting from condemnation proceedings or the taking of the Real Estate or any part thereof, under the power of emisent domain, or for any damage (whether caused by such taking or otherwise) to the Real Estate, or any rights appartenent thereto, including any award for change of grade of streets, and all payments for the voluntary sale of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, in lieu of the exercise of the power of eminent domain. The Mortgages is hereby authorized on behalf the mans of, the Mortgages to execute and delives valid acquittaness for, and appeal from, any such judgments or awards. The Mortgages may apply all such sums so received, or any part thereof, after the payment of all the Mortgages's expenses in connection with any proceeding or transaction described in this subparagraph 2, including court costs and attorneys' fees, on the Debt in such manner as the Mortgages election, at the Mortgages's option, the entire amount, or any part thereof, so received may be released or may be used to rebuild, report or reviors any or all of the improvements located on the Real Estate.

The Mortgagor agrees to take good care of the Real Estate and all improvements located thereon and not to commit or permit any waste thereon and at all times to maintain such improvements in as good condition as they now are, reasonable wear and tear excepted

Netwishstanding any other provision of this mortgage or the note or notes evidencing the Debt, the Debt shall become immediately due and payable, at the option of the Mortgages, upon the conveyance of the Real Estate, or any part thereof or any interest therein

The Mortgagor agrees that no delay or failure of the Mortgagor to exercise any option to deciare the Debt due and payable shall be deemed a waiver of the Mortgagor's right to exercise such option, either as to any past or present default, and it is agreed that no terms or conditions contained in this mortgage may be waived, altered or changed except by a written instrument signed by the Mortgagor and signed on behalf of the Mortgagos by one of its officers.

After default on the part of the Mortgagor, the Mortgagos, upon bill filed or other proper legal proceeding being commenced for the foreshouse of this mortgage, shall be entitled to the appointment by any competent court, without notice to any party, of a receiver for the rents, seases, revenues and profits of the Real Estate, with power to lease and control the Real Estate, and with such other powers as may be deemed necessary

The Mortgagor agrees that the Mortgagos may bid at any sale had under the terms of this mortgage and may purchase the Real Estate if the highest bidder therefor. The Mortgagor agrees to pay all costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred by the Mortgages in collecting or securing or estumpting to collect or secure the Debt, or any part thereof, or in defending or attempting to defend the priority of this mortgage against any han or entumbrance on the Real Estate, unless this mortgage is herein expressly made subject to any such lies or encumbrance, and/or all costs incurred in the forecingure of this mortgage, either under the power of sale contained herein, or by virtue of the decree of any court of competent jurisdiction. The full amount of such costs incurred by the Mortgages shall be a part of the Debt and shall be secured by this mortgage. The purchaser at any such sale shall be under no obligation to see to the proper application of the purchase money. In the event of a sale hereunder, the Mortgages, or the owner of the Debt and mortgage, or auctioneer, shall execute to the purchaser, for and in the name of the Mortgagor, a statutory warranty deed to the Real Estate.
