MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED MAY 24, 2000, between WILLIAM L JOHNSON and CONNIE C JOHNSON, HUSBAND AND WIFE, whose address is 1118 ELM DRIVE, ALABASTER, AL 35007 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and AmSouth Bank, whose address is 1235 First Street North, Alabaster, AL 35007 (referred to below as "Lander").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, grants, bergeins, salts and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings improvements and fixtures; all essements, rights of way, and appurtenances, all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in SHELBY County, State of Alabama (the "Real Property"):

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 1118 ELM DRIVE, ALABASTER, AL 35007.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property in addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section "

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means WILLIAM & JOHNSON and CONNIE C JOHNSON. The Grantor is the mortgager under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodate of parties in connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements foul fingle structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions, replacements and other construction on the Real Property

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advance to by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Morrgage together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Morrgage, and any and all other present or future, direct or contribute to indebtedness of any person who signs the Note to the Lender of any nature whatsoever, whether classified as secured or unsecuted except that the word "Indebtedness" shall not include any debt subject to the disclosure requirements of the Federal Truth in Lending Act at the time such debt is incurred, any legally required disclosure of the lien afforded hereby with respect to such debt shall not have been made.

Lender. The word "Lender" means AmSouth Bank, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgages under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated May 24, 2000, in the original principal amount of \$25,500.00 from Grentor to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of consolidations of and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The maturity date of this Mortgage is June 1, 2015.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to a replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property, and together with all proceeds findluding without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements of an agreements, and all other instruments, agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements, and documents, whether now or hersafter existing, executed in connection with the Indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, revalues, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY. IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS.

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by the Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be go verged to the following provisions:

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements. And maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability A. 1 of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9801, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986. Pub. I No. 99.499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 8901, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the terms "hazardous waste" and "hazardous substance" shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by products or any fraction thereof and asbestos. Any inspections or tests made by Lander shall be for Lander's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lander to Grantor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due diligence in investigating the Property for hezardous weste and hazardous substances. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and libr agrees to internally and hold harmiess Lander against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lander may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of this section of the Mortgage or as a consequence of any use generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or threatened release of a hezerdous waste or substance on the properties. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indomnify, shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lien of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Property. whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Nuisance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or "... the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Grantor will not remove on grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent. " Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demotish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any Improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lander's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend " Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter. in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lander's may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the charecter and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage UPXIII. the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A 'sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Risal Property of any right, title or interest therein, whether legal, beneficial or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, lessehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Granton is a corporation ipartnership of limited liability company, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty five percent (25%) of the voting stock, partnership interests or limited liability company interests, as the case may be, of Granton. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Alabama law

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing indebtedness. referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph:

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lander's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment. Grantor shall within fifteen (16) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filled, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filling. secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could account as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgmer " before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished in any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialments lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grentor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Granton can and will pay the cost of such improvements

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage:

Maintenance of insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements of a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to evoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies. and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days, prior written notice to cervier. and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Each insurance policy also shall include at endorsement providing that coverage in favor of Lender will not be impaired in any way by any act, omission or default of Grantor or areother person. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergen is Management Agency as a special flood hazard area. Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood Insurance for the full unperprincipal balance of the loan and any prior liens on the property securing the loan, up to the maximum policy limits set under the National Flood Insurance Program, or as otherwise required by Lender, and to maintain such insurance for the term of the loan

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lander may make proof of RISA. 1 Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired. Lender may at its election. apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any hen affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the demaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default under this Mortgage. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to pay accrued interest, and the remainder if any shall be applied to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered to. this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which any Existing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the Instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of ghe proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests to the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the fate provided for in the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date. It repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand. (b) be added to the balance of the Note and the apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (ii) the term of any applicable insurance point, in (iii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies in which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple free and itear of a constant and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or a large insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by Lender in a onnestico with this Mirrigage of the Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of cender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding that Lander shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's lawn choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to parmit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Uen. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to an existing fien. Grantor express, covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, are default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

Default. If the payment of any installment of principal or any interest on the Existing Indebtedness is not made within the time required to the note evidencing such indebtedness, or should a default occur under the instrument securing such indebtedness and not be duried during any applicable grace period therein, then, at the option of Lender, the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall be come immediately that and payable, and this Mortgage shall be in default.

No Medification. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lander. Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lander.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgager

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding purchase in lieu of condemnation, Landar May at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees indurred by Landar in connection with the condemnation

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, the Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Landar such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxon less and charges are a part of this Mortgage;

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and their whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse condent all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon at the arry part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage. (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage: (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made to Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes, If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a pair or this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shell constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or either personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested to tender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in true real property records, Lender may, at lany time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lander

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lander Isacured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained leach as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney in fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will make to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender cause to be filed, recorded, refiled or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor.
