If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, Borrower will be given written notice of the change in accordance with paragraph 14 above and applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any other Information required by applicable law.
- 20. Hazardoùs Substances. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardoùs Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental i.aw. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small quantities of Hazardoùs Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Property.
