I, J. RAYMON FREY, a resident of the State of Alabama, Jefferson County, do declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

ARTICLE I

I direct that all of my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as may be practicable. In the event that there is any indebtedness owing by me, whether secured or unsecured, which has not matured at the time of my death, I authorize my Executor to pay such indebtedness either in full or according to the terms and tenor of any instrument evidencing such indebtedness, as my Executor may deem best advisable under the then existing circumstances. I further direct that all estate and inheritance taxes which may be asserted or levied with respect to my estate, or any part thereof, whether passing under this Will or otherwise, shall be paid out of my residuary estate as an expense of administration and without apportionment.

ARTICLE II

All of the property which I may own at the time of my death, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, including all property which I may acquire or become entitled to after the execution of this Will, I give, bequeath and devise to my wife, SARAH B. FREY.

If my said wife shall not survive me, I give, bequeath and devise all of the aforesaid property to my children, ROY WAYNE FREY, LLOYD CECIL FREY and PAUL RAYMON FREY, in fee and in equal shares. If any of my said children shall not survive me, his share thereof shall pass to his then living issue, per stirpes, if any, and if none, then the whole thereof shall pass to my other named children, if living, and if not, to their then living issue, per stirpes.

FREY, to be the Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and I direct that my Executrix shall be exempt from posting bond, filing any inventory of the property coming into her hands as Executrix, and making any report or final settlement to any court of her proceedings hereunder. I vest my said Executrix with full power and authority to sell, transfer and convey any property, real or personal, which I may own at the time of my death, or which she may thereafter acquire as Executrix, at such time and price and upon such terms and conditions (including credit) as she may determine, and to do every other act and thing necessary or appropriate for the complete administration of my estate.

If my said wife shall predecease me, or for any reason shall fail to qualify as Executrix hereunder (or having qualified, shall die or resign), then in such event, I appoint my son, LLOYD CECIL FREY, to be the Executor of my estate.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, J. RAYMON FREY, the testator, sign my name to this instrument (containing in all three [3] pages, including the attestation clause), this 2 day of March, 1983, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and Testament, and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am nineteen years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.
