ARTICLE I – NAME

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

The corporation has been organized for the following purposes:

ARTICLE VIII – CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate power shall be exercised by the Board of Directors. Except as otherwise provided by statute or by these ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION. In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized:

1. To make and alter the By-Laws of the Corporation, but By-Laws so made by the directors may be altered or repealed by the directors or stockholders.
2. To fix and determine and vary the amount of working capital of the Corporation; to determine whether any, and if any, what part of accumulated profits shall be declared and paid as dividends; to determine the date or dates of the declaration and payment dividends; to direct and determine the use and disposition of any surplus or net profits over and above the capital stock paid in.
3. To increase the size of the Board of Directors as they deem appropriate; and to conduct board meetings by telephone when warranted.

The corporation may, in its By-Laws, confer powers upon its Board of Directors in addition to the foregoing.
