

SCRIVENER'S AFFIDAVIT

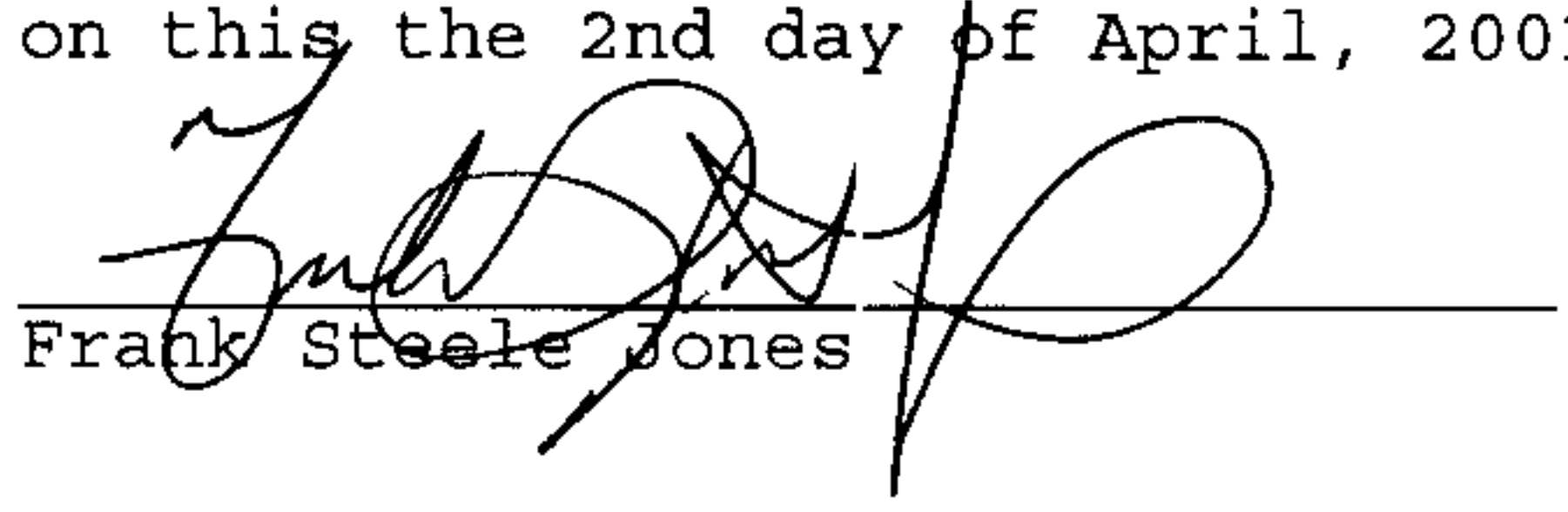

Further the Affiant sayeth not.

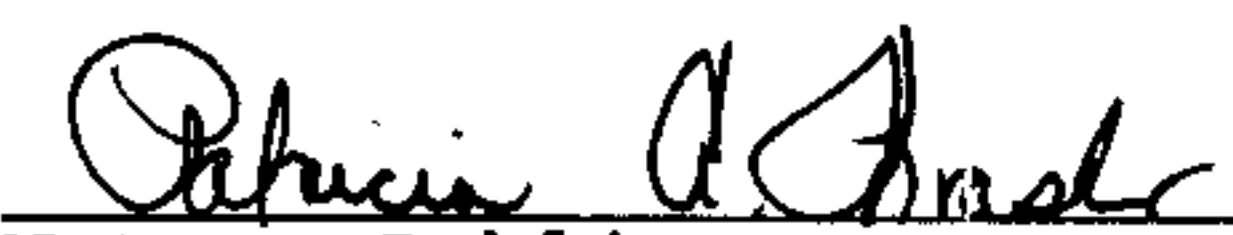
